Stanislaus County Parks and Recreation Presents the 7th Annual Egg Hunt at Modesto Reservoir

Modesto, CA – Stanislaus County Parks and Recreation and the Board of Supervisors present the 7th Annual Egg Hunt taking place at Woodward Reservoir on April 1, 2023 from 10:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The Egg Hunt will feature four huge egg hunts and an array of other free games and activities.

There will be four Egg Hunts to cater to different age groups, with a total of over 12,000 eggs. The hunts are scheduled as followed: Toddler and Special Needs Egg Hunt for ages 1-2 starts at 11:00 a.m., Kiddie Egg Hunt for ages 3-5 starts at 11:30 a.m., Junior Egg Hunt for ages 6-8 at 12:00 p.m., and finally the Big Kid Egg Hunt for ages 9-11 starts at 12:30 p.m. Each hunt will have special eggs containing golden tickets hidden throughout. Whoever finds these special eggs will win a bike, there will be one in each age group. Other special tickets in the eggs are for baskets filled with prizes.

The Parks Bunny himself will be available for photo opportunities starting at 10:30 a.m. Other attractions include crafts, face painting, train rides, and many more activities. The first 200 children to check in at the event will receive a free goodie bag of treats. Food vendors will also be present, serving hot dogs, hamburgers, pretzels, shaved ice, and other kid-friendly fare.

“Parks and Recreation enriches lives by providing family-friendly events throughout the year to our community, and the Egg Hunt supports that.” said Tera Chumley, Director, Stanislaus County Parks and Recreation.

But the real prize for families is a trip to scenic Modesto Reservoir, and a chance to spend some quality family time out of the house.

“Modesto Reservoir is a local treasure,” Chumley said. “The Egg Hunt is a great opportunity for families to experience the outdoors, showing them a local attraction they can experience any day of the week.”

Modesto Reservoir is located at 18143 Reservoir Rd., Waterford, CA 95386. Admission to the Modesto Reservoir is \$15/\$20 resident/nonresident per vehicle. To preserve the reservoir’s water, no dogs or gasoline containers are allowed.
