

Don't Trash Stanislaus County!

Illegal dumping and litter is a problem throughout the State. In Stanislaus County, the Department of Environmental Resources provides no-or low-cost clean-up programs to its residents in order to Keep Stanislaus County Beautiful.

The following clean-up programs are sponsored and/or offered by the Board of Supervisors and the Department of Environmental Resources:

Residential Bulky Item Collection Program

Available to all residents in the unincorporated area of Stanislaus County who are subscribing to garbage service. Qualifying residents can have bulky items picked up at their homes two times per year.

Community Clean-Up Events

Each quarter, the Department of Environmental Resources sponsors or partners with the Stanislaus County Community Redevelopment Division on community-wide clean up events. Residents of these communities have the opportunity to dispose of many hard-to-handle items that will not fit into a standard garbage cart/can. When possible, other items can be included in the clean-up such as tires, general refuse and household hazardous waste. Residents are notified when a clean-up event is scheduled in their community.

Weed and Seed Program

Weed and Seed is a community-based, collaborative effort that builds partnerships between federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies, prosecutors, social service providers, government agencies, businesses and neighborhood residents under the shared goal of "weeding" out violent crime, gang activity and blight, while "seeding" in social services and neighborhood revitalization. Residents in the Weed and Seed area's have the opportunity to dispose of hard to handle/bulky items such as furniture and appliances as well as yard prunings, tires and general refuse at the clean-up events.



Oakdale Drop Off

ALL Stanislaus County Residents can drop off bulky items and hard-to-handle waste in Oakdale, at 551 S. Center St. Hours: Friday 10am—5pm and Saturday: 9am—4pm. Please show proof of garbage service (garbage bill), & proof of residency (driver's license). The fee is \$10.00 per load.
