



STANISLAUS COUNTY FINK ROAD SANITARY LANDFILL

WHEN: 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday thru Saturday **CLOSED SUNDAYS**
Closed: July 4th, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.

WHO: Open to all private citizens, rubbish haulers, gardeners, municipalities, school districts, and County Agencies.

WHAT: All types of commercial and household waste **except** car bodies, septic tank waste, toxic materials, liquid waste (i.e., paints, thinners, used oil, etc.) cannery waste, closed containers, car batteries. If you have **televisions or computers you must notify the attendant so appropriate paperwork can be filled out. Batteries have their own designated site, so please let attendant know (AAA, AA, C, D Cell, etc.). White goods (appliances) must be declared so that they can be separated for diversion.**

HOW MUCH: (Effective January 1, 2006, per CA law, all vehicles are required to weigh on scale. Weighing of vehicles does not impact current prices). Fee authority: Calif. Government Code Section 25823.

PRICE BY LOAD:

Passenger cars, Station wagons, Blazers and Mini Vans	\$ 5.00/load
Pick-ups (without sideboards) and Full Size Vans	\$10.00/load

Sideboards – Anything used to contain the load and extend the height of a pick-up bed or trailer.

Two-wheel trailers (without sideboards , within the following dimensions) 8' maximum length, 3' maximum height.	\$10.00/load
Four-wheel trailers (without sideboards , within the following dimensions) 8' maximum length, 3' maximum height	\$15.00/load

Trailers are measured in entirety from the outside, end-to-end (excluding tongue), and bottom-to-top.

Tires	Car/pick-up (9 or less with or without rims)	\$1.00/each
	Truck (9 or less with or without rims)	\$5.00/each
	Tractor (with or without rims) – Smaller than 20.5 x 25	\$7.00/each
	Earthmover Tires – 20.5 x 25 or larger	\$45.00/each

Hauling 10 or more tires requires a Permit Issued by the California Integrated Waste Mgmt. Board

CHECKS, VISA AND MASTER CARD ARE ACCEPTED:

The individual paying by check or credit card must have a valid California Driver's License or California ID Card in their possession otherwise the check or credit card will be refused.

PRICE BY THE TON:

Weighed vehicles are ALL pick-ups and trailers with sideboards, trailers over the maximum length and/or height, all flatbed pick-ups, modified pick-ups with tool boxes and dual wheels, and all other vehicles not listed in other categories.

Normal Refuse: Garbage, paper, lumber, bottles, cans, small dead (household) animals, household trash, garden refuse, demolition, construction debris.	\$33.00/ton (See min. charge below)
Non-Friable Asbestos (see below): Taken only with approval letter from the Stanislaus County Department of Environmental Resources. Tuesday through Friday ONLY, 9 a.m. to 2 p.m., must call to arrange.	\$100.00/ton with min. fee of \$20.00
Hard-to-Handle (Bulk Material): RV trailers, mobile homes, lg. loads of small dead animals, lg. dead animals, lg. plastic sheets, wire, bailing twine, tree stumps/logs & whole trees, treated wood, non-friable asbestos , lg. tanks, long/large pipe, lg. chunks of concrete, boats, pontoons, lg. sheets of foam or aluminum siding, sensitive records, spoiled/damaged finished food products, & all other material over 4x4. Tuesday though Friday ONLY, 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Only accept 1 boat or mobile home per day. Must call ahead to schedule an appointment.	\$100.00/ton or \$10.00 each for 5 or fewer sm. dead animals. Min. charge of \$20.00 – all types
Special Handling: Any material that has to have a special hole dug and buried immediately. Must call to arrange an appointment. Tues. – Fri. ONLY, 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. *Loads of large dead animals require a written request from the Director of the Office of Emergency Services	\$100.00/ton* or \$30.00 each** for 5 or fewer Lg. dead animals/\$50.00 min. fee for 6 or more small dead animals
Solid Material (Inert): Dirt, rock, gravel, concrete, asphalt, plaster, brick, roofing tile and sheetrock. This must be clean, if mixed with any other material not listed as Inert it will be considered Normal Refuse.	\$5.00/ton (See min. charge below)
Tires: Car/pick-up and Truck Only (10 or more – with or without rims)	\$100.00/ton
MINIMUM CHARGE: Trucks or Two-wheel trailers	\$10.00/load
Four-wheel trailers	\$15.00/load
Truck and Two-wheel trailer***	\$20.00/load
Truck and Four-wheel trailer***	\$25.00/load

** Must be pre-approved by landfill staff ***If both contain any amount of any type of refuse.

Sm. dead animals: goats, feeder pigs, sheep & smaller. Lg. dead: cattle, breeding sows, boars & larger

Dear Valued Customer:

The State of California and the County of Stanislaus, encourages you to recycle everything you can. However, when you need to bring your non-recyclables to the Landfill, per the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB), and Stanislaus County, the following rules must be followed while using the facility:

1. **SAFETY FIRST.** Signs are posted and will be strictly enforced.
2. For your safety, and ours, keep all children and pets in your vehicle (unless your children are helping you to unload your vehicle). This is considered a construction site. Large trucks and heavy equipment will be moving all over area.
3. Do not travel around outside the area in which you have been designated to unload your vehicle. You must remember that is a landfill. Please be aware of your surroundings. This is not the most **sanitary** place for you, your children, or your pets in which to roam.
4. While unloading, refrain from throwing objects from your vehicle. It is unsafe for you and for those around you.
5. Do not back up your vehicle and slam on the breaks in order to dislodge load. Doing so is very **unsafe** to you and those around you. (If special handling is required, please call to make arrangements ahead of time before coming to the site).
6. Any unacceptable or hazardous waste cannot be accepted at the landfill. Most of the communities in Stanislaus County have a designated area for those types of waste. We would be pleased to give you information on where to dispose of these items. Feel free to ask the scalehouse attendant or the vehicle spotter at the tipping area.
7. All California State vehicle codes are strictly enforced within the landfill.
8. All loads shall be covered. This is not only the law, but it helps keep our roadsides clear of debris.
9. Salvaging is strictly prohibited.
10. **UNAUTHORIZED AREAS ARE STRICTLY OFF LIMITS.**
