

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-02  
COUNTYWIDE SUCCESSOR AGENCY OVERSIGHT BOARD  
OF STANISLAUS COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act, Government Code section 81000, et seq., requires each public agency in California to adopt a conflict of interest code, to require that individuals occupying certain designated positions file Statements of Economic Interests upon entering office, annually while in office, and upon leaving office;

WHEREAS, regulations adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, 2 California Code of Regulations section 18730, provides that incorporation by reference of the terms of that regulation, along with an agency-specific appendix designating positions and disclosure categories shall constitute the adoption and amendment of a conflict of interest code in conformance with Government Code sections 87300 and 87306;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Countywide Successor Agency Oversight Board of Stanislaus County hereby adopts the Conflict of Interest Code attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein.




