The Triage and Engagement Program will respond throughout Stanislaus County as a follow-up to the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT). The Triage and Engagement Program provides a wide range of triage services to adults with mental illness and/or emotional disorders requiring crisis intervention in Stanislaus County, including those who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.

In order to be eligible for services, an individual must meet the following criteria:

- Must reside in Stanislaus County
- Be a minimum of 18 years of age
- Does not meet 5150 criteria
- Is not open to a treatment team at the point of referral

Triage and Engagement Program services are offered 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
