INTRODUCE, APPROVE, AND WAIVE THE FIRST READING OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11 OF THE STANISLAUS COUNTY CODE, SECTION 11.08.020 TO ADD NO PARKING ZONES ON CALIFORNIA AVENUE, DEL CIELO DRIVE, CLAUS ROAD, ABBIE STREET, AND GOLD VALLEY ROAD; AND SECTION 11.08.070 AMENDED TO EXTEND A PARKING PROHIBITED ON CERTAIN STREETS AT CERTAIN HOURS ZONE ON ELDER LANE (MODESTO).

DISCUSSION: A no parking zone on the south side of California Avenue west of Martin Luther King Drive was requested by an adjacent business and reviewed by County staff. Vehicles are parking along the curb and obstructing the view of motorists leaving and entering the business. Off street parking is readily available at the business, and there is no dependence on street parking.

A no parking zone at the pathway leading to the tennis courts on Del Cielo Drive was requested by the staff at the Del Rio Country Club. Occasionally tennis players chase stray balls into the street by running out between parked cars, causing a hazard to both pedestrians and the motoring public. This no parking zone will eliminate two to three parking spots.

A no parking zone at a mobile home park on Claus Road was requested by the owners of the mobile home park. There is adequate visitor and resident parking inside the park, and the on-street parking is not needed. The on-street parking does obstruct the vision of vehicles leaving the park.

A no parking zone on Abbie Street was requested by the California Highway Patrol and the Empire MAC. Vehicles parking along the curb are affecting the traffic turning onto State Route 132. The pavement width on Abbie Street is insufficient to accommodate parking and turning movements.

A parking prohibited on certain streets at certain hours zone on the north side of Elder Lane was requested by the adjacent landowner. This area is located near Beyer High School and students have been parking partly blocking the driveway for the residence. This zone will be an extension of an existing zone.

A no parking zone and a loading zone was requested by the Dena Boer School in Salida. These restrictions will aid the school by improving the circulation patterns of the parents dropping off their children.

The proposed ordinance has the recommendation of this Department and approval as to form from County Counsel. Therefore, it is recommended that you introduce the ordinance and waive the reading thereof.

ORDINANCE NO. C.S. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
NO PARKING ZONES, LOADING ZONES, AND PARKING
PROHIBITED ON CERTAIN STREETS AT CERTAIN HOURS
ON VARIOUS COUNTY ROADS

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS ORDAINS AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 11.08.020 (No Parking at Any Time) of the Stanislaus County Code Subsection 412 (Gold Valley Road) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"412. Gold Valley Road. On the south side of Gold Valley Road from a point 193 feet east of its intersection with Meadow Brook Lane, east 51 feet to a point 244 feet east of said intersection; and, on the south side of Golden Valley Road from a point 317 feet east of its intersection with Meadow Brook Lane, east 145 feet to a point 462 feet east of said intersection; and, on the south side of Gold Valley Road from a point 543 feet east of its intersection with Meadow Brook Lane, east 121 feet to a point 664 feet east of said intersection; and, on the south side of Gold Valley Road from a point 764 feet east of its intersection with Meadow Brook Lane, east 72 feet to a point 836 feet east of said intersection."

Section 2. Section 11.08.020 (No Parking at Any Time) of the Stanislaus County Code is hereby amended by adding Subsection 447 (Del Cielo Drive), Subsection 448 (California Avenue), Subsection 449 (Claus Road), and Subsection 450 (Abbie Street) to read as follows:

"447. Del Cielo Drive. On the west side of Del Cielo Drive from a point 570 feet north of its intersection with Stewart Road, north 60 feet to a point 630 feet north of said intersection."

"448. California Avenue. On the south side of California Avenue from a point 255 feet west of its intersection with Martin Luther King Drive, west 185 feet to a point 440 feet west of said intersection."

"449. Claus Road. On the east side of Claus Road from a point 1,490 feet south of its intersection with Claribel Road, south 250 feet to a point 1740 feet south of said intersection."

"450. Abbie Street. On the east and west side of Abbie Street from its intersection with Yosemite Avenue (State Route 132), south to a point 105 feet from said intersection."

Section 3. Section 11.08.070 (Parking Prohibited on Certain Streets at Certain Hours) of the Stanislaus County Code, Subsection B.20 (Elder Lane) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"20. Elder Lane. On the north side of Elder Lane from its intersection with Boyce Lane to a point 205 feet east of said intersection; parking is prohibited between the hours of eight a.m. and four p.m. on school days;"

Section 4. Section 11.12.020 (Yellow Zones -Established) of the Stanislaus County Code is hereby amended by adding Subsection J (Gold Valley Road) to read as follows:

"J. Gold Valley Road. On the south side of Gold Valley Road from a point 244 feet east of its intersection with Meadow Brook Lane, east 73 feet to a point 317 feet east of said intersection; and, on the south side of Gold Valley Road from a point 664 feet east of its intersection with Meadow Brook Lane, east 100 feet to a point 764 east of said intersection."

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days from and after the date of its passage, and before the expiration of 15 days after its passage, it shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.




