NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Tuesday, February 27, 2001, at the hour of 9:40 a.m., the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors will meet in their Chambers at 1010 10th Street, Modesto, CA, to discuss the Fiscal Year 2001 Community Development Block Grant program and to solicit citizen input.

Maximum award limits include a total of \$800,000 per year from the General and Economic Development Components combined. Up to \$500,000 per application per year may be awarded from either the General or Economic Development Components. Grants up to \$35,000 per year from the General Planning and Technical Assistance allocation and \$35,000 per year from the Economic Development Planning and Technical Assistance allocation may be awarded and do not count toward the \$800,000 cap.

The five major activity categories are Housing-New Construction, Housing-Acquisition, Housing-Rehabilitation, Community Facilities/Public Services, and Public Works. Projects funded with CDBG allocations must carry out at least one of three National Objectives, as follows: Benefit to Targeted Income Group (TIG) persons, elimination of slums and blight, and meeting urgent community development needs.

The Department of Planning and Community Development on behalf of Stanislaus County anticipates applying for the maximum grant amount of \$500,000 under the General Component for public works. Further, the department may apply for funds from the other Components of the CDBG Program.




