APPROVAL TO DECLARE AS SURPLUS AND DONATE COUNTY EQUIPMENT  
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**DISCUSSION:** The Stanislaus County Police Activities League (PAL) is a youth oriented, not-for-profit organization in Stanislaus County. They provide youngsters with alternatives to drugs, gangs, and other criminal activity by providing sports, tutoring, mentoring, and educational activities. Many of the youth lack transportation to the activity centers. As a result, PAL has requested our help in finding a van to transport young people to and from such activities. They have specifically requested that we donate or sell them such a vehicle at a discounted price. We have reviewed their request, and have determined that their request is worthy of consideration. We happen to have a van (vehicle 92-23) in our Fleet that is usable and would meet PAL's needs. This van was recently removed from service and was scheduled for auction. It is therefore recommended that the Board declare this van as surplus, and further authorize its donation to PAL. We are asking that the Board donate this vehicle because we believe that any money that we would make by selling it would be offset by cost savings/benefits that would accrue to our community by having its youth gainfully involved in the PAL-related activities previously mentioned.

**POLICY ISSUE:** The Board is required to declare as surplus and approve the donation of County equipment which exceeds \$1,000 per item. Moreover, approval of this recommendation is consistent with the Boards' goals of supporting a safe and healthy community, multi-jurisdictional cooperation, and community leadership.

**STAFFING IMPACT:** There is no staffing impact associated with this recommendation.
