NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Tuesday, March 27, 2001, at the hour of 9:30 A.M., the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors will meet in the Joint Board/Council Chambers at 1010 10th Street, Modesto, CA to conduct the second of two pre-application hearings regarding Community Development Block Grant Program funding. At this hearing, the following information shall be discussed: (1) an explanation of the CDBG program, (2) opportunity for attendees to ask questions and suggest possible uses of funds, (3) information about the amount of funding available, the range of possible activities that may be undertaken with CDBG funds, and the opportunity for citizen involvement as the program progresses, (4) national objective of benefit to Targeted Income Group (TIG) persons or other national objective, (5) plans to minimize displacement that may occur as a result of grant funding, (6) assessments resulting from a CDBG-funded project will not be paid by members of the Lowest Targeted Income Group and whether Targeted Income Group households who benefit from the project must pay any assessments, (7) information about the availability of technical assistance to groups representing TIG persons that request such assistance in developing proposals, (8) the description of the proposed activity(s) in the application, (9) the amount of funding being requested (\$500,000), (10) where each activity will be carried out and how it will meet the national objective of benefit to TIG persons, and (11) the estimated time schedule to accomplish the activity.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that at the above noticed time and place interested persons will be given an opportunity to be heard. Interested persons may also submit written comments to Stanislaus County regarding the Community Development Block Grant Program during Fiscal Year 1999/00.
