FISCAL
IMPACT:

The original pest detection contract provided for reimbursement for program expenses up to \$64,221 for fiscal year 2000/01. The amendment increases the funding by \$1,250 to an amended total of \$65,471. The increased funding amount reimburses the Agricultural Commissioner's Office for additional equipment and supplies necessary to the pest detection program. It is requested that appropriations and revenue be increased in the amount of \$1,250 to reflect this amended contract.

APPROVAL OF AMENDED FISCAL YEAR 2000/01 PEST DETECTION CONTRACT WITH
THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURE

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DISCUSSION:

Pest detection is a critical program which detects pests injurious to agriculture. Detection trapping is a vital part of the pest prevention effort. The most serious pests are not native to this area but have been introduced and allowed to gain a foothold. The trapping program targets pests with the most serious potential, such as Medfly. If incipient infestations are detected, we can eradicate them before they become established. This effort is of enormous benefit to the County's agriculture.

On September 12, 2000, the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors approved the Fiscal Year 2000/01 Pest Detection program contract with the California Department of Food and Agriculture. The original contract provided for program reimbursement in the amount of \$64,221. The amended contract increases Stanislaus County's share of the funding by \$1,250 to a total of \$65,471 for fiscal year 2000/01. It is requested that appropriations and revenue be increased in the amount of \$1,250 to reflect this amended contract. This contract revision augments the existing contract to cover additional supplies necessary to the Pest Detection program. This is a vital program for the protection of Stanislaus County agriculture.

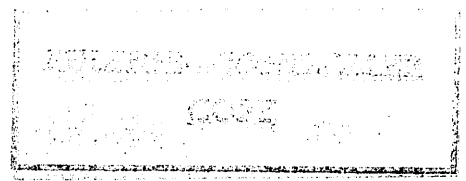
POLICY ISSUE:

The CCC will be kept on file in this office and must be renewed every three (3) years and as changes occur. It is available on the Internet at the above site referenced in paragraph one. Please sign and return the current CCC. Failure to do so will prohibit the State of California from doing business with your company.
- A copy of your insurance certification which states coverage will not be canceled without 30 days written notice to the State of California and which also includes the State of California, its officers, agents and employees as additional insureds.
