AUTHORIZE THE PROVISIONAL APPOINTMENT OF JAMES WHEELLESS TO A POSITION OF EMERGENCY DISPATCHER, STANISLAUS REGIONAL 9-1-1, AT THE FIFTH STEP OF THE SALARY RANGE (\$19.76 PER HOUR)

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DISCUSSION:

Mr. Wheelless' previously held the positions at Stanislaus Regional 9-1-1 of Emergency Dispatcher, Senior Emergency Dispatcher and Department Systems Coordinator (currently called Systems Engineer II) for 16 years prior to his resignation November 25, 1999.

Mr. Wheelless' has 16 years of experience with our department and would be a tremendous asset with his expertise and knowledge of the department throughout. We are fortunate to have Mr. Wheelless returning to California.

Mr. Wheelless' prior experience will permit him to work in the department on system/software needs as well as lend support to the dispatch staff. Mr. Wheelless' left at Step 5 and with the difficulties we have recruiting staff make Mr. Wheelless an ideal candidate.

POLICY ISSUES:

This recommendation supports the Board's priority of Efficient Government Operations.

STAFFING IMPACTS:

There will be no staffing impact associated with this action, Mr. Wheelless would be filling an existing vacancy.
