Dear Members of the Board of Supervisors:

The United Way of Stanislaus County is requesting the use of Bonita Pool and park area as well as waiving the exclusive use fee for the fourth annual Great Westside Duck Race that will be held on October 13, 2001. This is a rubber duck event where individuals adopt a duck for \$5.00 and if their duck is retrieved they will receive a prize, such as trips, shopping spree, etc.

The United Way agrees to carry liability insurance for the event as well as hold harmless the Parks and Recreation Department of Stanislaus County. In addition, United Way will provide a certified lifeguard.

All the proceeds from this event will be distributed to programs that will serve the residents living along the "33 corridor".

The activities will begin at 11:30 AM with a parade that leads to the pool, with the "race" beginning at 1:00 PM. There will be a "service club challenge" and a "corporate challenge" where representatives will attempt to move their 18" rubber duck across the wading pool without any physical contact with the duck. The main duck race will follow, with 2000 2" rubber ducks being released in the wading pool and rescued in the same procedure as last year. Following the "race" there will be activities for families, such as a barbecue, games, displays, etc. until 3:00 PM.
