SUBJECT:
AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES TO ACCEPT AND USE BEVERAGE CONTAINER RECYCLING FUNDS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION

- STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

 2. APPROVE THE 2000-2001 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET AS IDENTIFIED IN ATTACHMENT "B"; AND
 3. AUTHORIZE THE AUDITOR-CONTROLLER TO MAKE THE NECESSARY FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS WITHIN THE EXISTING ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES FUND AND ORGANIZATION ACCOUNT AS IDENTIFIED IN ATTACHMENT "B", AND ROLL FORWARD UNEXPENDED APPROPRIATIONS INTO FISCAL YEAR 01/02 AND IN FUTURE YEARS.

FISCAL IMPACT:

These funds would provide \$66,844 in fiscal year 00/01 to the Department's existing Assembly Bill 939 Special Revenue Account, from the California Department of Conservation, to promote beverage container recycling in the cities of Newman, Oakdale, Patterson, Turlock and Waterford and the unincorporated areas of Stanislaus County. These funds will roll forward to fiscal year 01/02 if unexpended.

AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES TO ACCEPT AND USE BEVERAGE CONTAINER RECYCLING FUNDS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION

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DISCUSSION: WHY is this agenda item important to our customers?

To ensure a safe and healthy community and to take pride in our local communities by providing additional incentives to recycle.

WHAT is the historical/current situation? What is the benchmark? What are the expected outcomes?

In the 1980s, Assembly Bill 2020 (AB 2020), more commonly known as the “Bottle Bill”, was enacted. It was this bill that created the surcharge at the time of purchase on most bottled beverages such as soda pop, wine coolers, beer, etc. AB 2020 was scheduled to sunset in 1999, but was re-authorized provided changes were made to the program’s design. The most significant change for local government was the return of some of the surcharge monies to the local level for the enhancement of beverage container recycling efforts.

Specifically, Section 14581(a)(4)(A) of the Beverage Container Recycling and Litter Reduction Act was revised to require that \$10.5 million be returned annually to cities and counties on a per capita basis. Jurisdictions can apply for funds either individually or jointly, and this year Stanislaus County’s per capita share is \$31,462. The cities of Newman, Oakdale, Patterson, Turlock and Waterford have expressed their desire to participate jointly with the county in this effort. Their respective shares for this year will be \$5,000 each, with the exception of Turlock whose share is \$15,382, making a grand total of \$66,844 available for this purpose in fiscal year 01/02.

The year 2000 was the first year these funds were allocated to local jurisdictions. Beginning with the year 2001, the Department of Conservation has informed staff that formal applications, accompanied by a resolution, will no longer be required. Moreover, they require only that the attached funding requests (Attachment “A”) be signed by the person originally authorized in the year 2000; specifically, the Director of Environmental Resources.

The Department of Environmental Resources will continue to serve as the lead agency in this project and will use these funds to supplement existing local recycling efforts as follows: a) advertising which is tailored to support each local program; b) promotional items to enhance these programs and “close the loop” through the purchase of end-use items such as park benches/tables made of recycled content; c) equipment/supplies

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such as recycling containers and signs for public areas; and d) staffing costs. Attachment "B" includes the proposed budget for fiscal year 00/01. Funds will be allocated in a similar manner in future years. Staff recommends that the Board authorize the Director of Environmental Resources to sign the enclosed funding requests, both for fiscal year 00/01 and in future years.

HOW will the item/these recommendations be accomplished?

Department staff will work cooperatively with the cities of Newman, Oakdale, Patterson, Turlock and Waterford to purchase needed equipment and promotional items, and to tailor advertising specific to each jurisdiction which will enhance beverage container diversion efforts locally.

**POLICY
ISSUE:**

The Board should decide if the Department should accept these funds. Such funding would assist the county, together with the cities of Newman, Oakdale, Patterson, Turlock and Waterford, in meeting waste reduction, recycling and educational goals. The Board's approval of this report is consistent with its priorities of ensuring a safe and healthy community and achieving multi-jurisdictional cooperation.
