Dear Mr. Cummins:

Your request for the use of the Stanislaus County Courthouse Lawn and electricity on Tuesday July 4th for activities in connection with the Fourth of July parade was approved by the Board of Supervisors at their meeting of June 12, 2001.

The County requires you to have a \$1 million insurance policy which names Stanislaus County as co-insured on the policy. You must show a certificate of insurance to the Parks Department Office, 3800 Cornucopia Way, Suite C, Modesto, **no later than three days prior to your event.** If your organization does not have an existing insurance policy, you may wish to have another organization or group, which has insurance sponsor the event. If your organization is affiliated with a national organization, it is likely that the national organization has insurance, which may cover this event.

If you have any questions regarding insurance requirements, please contact Risk Management at 558-6338.

Also, It will also be necessary for each participant of this event to sign the Hold Harmless Agreement before participating in the activity. Please contact the Parks Department at 525-6771 for further information.

Your organization must remove all personal property immediately after the event and must leave the area in a clean and orderly manner. Any questions regarding user's responsibilities or release can be directed to Director of Parks, 525-6750.
