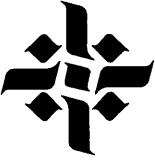

The following members of the Stanislaus Children's Council have expressed their desire for reappointment upon expiration of their terms on June 30, 2001.


- ❖ Richards Jacobs – *Representative of a local planning agency participating in the California Early Intervention Program*
