**DISCUSSION:** In May of 2000, a 1988 Pontiac Firebird was donated by Sgt. Mike Richards to the Sheriff's Employees' Foundation (non-profit) for the Department's DARE Unit for use at DARE-related activities. This transaction was handled through the Sheriff's Employees' Foundation which is responsible for the bookkeeping for the DARE Unit.

It is the request of the Sheriff's Department that this vehicle be added to the County fleet and then assigned to the DARE Unit for DARE-related activities.

**POLICY ISSUES:** The Board must determine if receipt of this vehicle is consistent with the Board's stated priority of modeling community leadership.

**STAFFING IMPACTS:** None. The staff currently assigned to the DARE Unit will utilize the donated equipment in a manner consistent with established County guidelines.
