RESOLUTION FOR DR. ROBERT W. WATSON, JR.

WHEREAS, Dr. Robert W. Watson, Jr., served as Stanislaus County Public Health Officer from 1972 to 1978, providing leadership of programs such as air pollution control, environmental health, Crippled Children's Services, Community Health and Disability Prevention, public health nursing, family planning, Maternal and Child Health, communicable disease clinic and public health laboratory services; and

WHEREAS, he was a well-respected pediatrician, serving Stanislaus County children from 1957 to 1967; and

WHEREAS, he passed away at the age of 77 on October 1, 2000, after having served his community as a dedicated pediatrician and Public Health Officer; and

WHEREAS, his former patients, employees and colleagues wish to honor his caring, dedicated commitment to the community and the County of Stanislaus,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors does hereby unanimously commend posthumously Dr. Robert W. Watson, Jr., for his commitment to meeting the health care needs of the citizens of Stanislaus County.
