DISCUSSION:

The Department of Parks and Recreation has received a request for exclusive use of Salida Park, Salida, to conduct a community outreach program by various community service organizations. The programs would be held on every Wednesday in August for five weeks to reach out to the children of the community to conduct health and safety programs.

The teaching activities would be conducted by staff of the Modesto Irrigation District, the United States Department of Agriculture, Pak-n-Save Stores, Sheriff Department, American Medical Response & Fire Departments, churches from Salida, and other health care providers, such as local veterinarians, doctors and dentists.

The Department of Parks and Recreation recommends that the Board approve the staff recommendations.

POLICY
