Dear Terry:

Your request for the use of the back dam area of Modesto Reservoir for your "Ski Day For Kids" with the Police Activities League on Saturday August 25, 2001 was approved by the Board of Supervisors at their meeting on August 14, 2001.

Entrance fees have been waived for participants and volunteers at this event.

The County requires you to have a \$1 million insurance policy which names Stanislaus County as additional insured on the policy. You will need to give a certificate of insurance to the Parks Department Office, 3800 Cornucopia Way, Suite C, in Modesto, **no later than seven days prior to your event.** If your organization does not have an existing insurance policy, you may wish to have another organization or group which has insurance sponsor the event. If your organization is affiliated with a national organization, it is likely that the national organization has insurance which may cover this event.

It will also be necessary for each participant of this event to sign the Hold Harmless Agreement before participating in the activity.

Also, in the event of low water that prevents launching boats at other ramps, Mid-Valley Water Ski Club will need to permit other boaters, if there are any, to launch and retrieve boats at the back dam area.
