

ORDINANCE NO. C.S.- 766

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1.08.020, 1.08.030, 1.08.040, 1.08.050 and 1.08.060 of the Stanislaus County Code is amended to read as follows:

1.08.020 District No. 1

Supervisorial District No. 1 shall consist of all that territory in Stanislaus County lying within the following described boundaries:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the centerline of the Stanislaus River and the west line of Section 19, Township 2 South, Range 10 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, said point being the approximate southerly projection of Victory Road; thence along the following courses:

- A. North approximately 21.8 miles on the Stanislaus-San Joaquin County line, being on the west line of Range 10 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, to the intersection with the Calaveras County line;
- B. Southeasterly approximately 38.00 miles on the Stanislaus-Calaveras-Tuolumne County line to the intersection with the centerline of the Tuolumne River;
- C. Westerly approximately 33.60 miles meandering the centerline of the Tuolumne River, downstream to its intersection with the centerline of Mitchell Road;
- D. Northwesterly and northerly approximately two miles on the centerline of Mitchell Road to its intersection with the centerline of Yosemite Boulevard;
- E. North approximately 1.00 mile on the centerline of El Vista Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Dry Creek;
- F. Easterly approximately 1.35 miles meandering the centerline of Dry Creek, upstream to its intersection with the centerline of Lakewood Avenue;
- G. North approximately 1.65 miles on the centerline of Roselle and Lakewood Avenues to the intersection with the centerline of Floyd Avenue;
- H. West on the centerline of Floyd Avenue approximately 1.00 mile to the centerline of Oakdale Road;

- I. North approximately 0.75 mile on the centerline of Oakdale Road to its intersection with the centerline of Sylvan Avenue;
- J.. Westerly approximately 1.00 mile on the centerline of Sylvan Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Coffee Road;
- K. North on the centerline of Coffee Road and the east line of Section 21 and 28, T. 2 S., R. 9 E., Mount Diablo Meridian approximately 4.28 miles to its intersection with the centerline of the Stanislaus River;
- L. Easterly approximately 2.45 miles meandering the centerline of the Stanislaus River upstream and on the Stanislaus-San Joaquin County line to its intersection with the west line of Section 19, Township 2 South, Range 10 East, Mount Diablo Meridian and the point of beginning of this description.

1.08.030 District No. 2

Supervisory District No. 2 shall consist of all that territory in Stanislaus County lying within the following described boundaries:

BEGINNING at the most easterly corner of Stanislaus County in Section 36, Township 3 South, Range 14 East, Mount Diablo Meridian; thence along the following courses:

- A. Southwesterly approximately 36.00 miles on the Stanislaus-Merced County line to the centerline of the San Joaquin River;
- B. Northerly and downstream following the centerline of the San Joaquin River approximately 4.50 miles to the centerline of Crows Landing Road;
- C. Northeasterly on the centerline of Crows Landing Road approximately 10.60 miles to the centerline of Service Road;
- D. East approximately 2.67 miles on the centerline of Service Road to its intersection with the centerline of the Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way;
- E. Southeasterly approximately 0.55 miles on the centerline of Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way to its intersection with the centerline of the Turlock Irrigation District's Ceres Main canal;
- F. Easterly and northerly approximately 2.46 miles on the centerline of said Ceres Main canal to its intersection with the centerline of Hatch Road;
- G. West approximately 0.13 miles on said centerline of Hatch Road to its intersection with the centerline of Mitchell Road;
- H. North approximately 0.53 miles on the centerline of Mitchell Road to its intersection with the centerline of the Tuolumne River;

- I. Meander said centerline of the Tuolumne River easterly and upstream approximately 33.60 miles to the Stanislaus-Tuolumne County line in Section 16, Township 3 South, Range 14 East, Mount Diablo Meridian;
- J. Southeasterly approximately 4.00 miles on said County line to the point of beginning of this description.

1.08.040 District No.3

Supervisory District No. 3 shall consist of all that territory in Stanislaus County lying within the following described boundaries:

BEGINNING at the junction of the Stanislaus River and the San Joaquin River lying in Section 19, Township 3 South, Range 7 East, Mount Diablo Meridian; thence along the following courses:

- A. Meander the centerline of the San Joaquin River southeasterly upstream approximately 8.15 miles to its junction with the centerline of the Tuolumne River;
- B. Meander said centerline of the Tuolumne River easterly upstream approximately 14.71 miles to its intersection with the centerline of the Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way;
- C. Northwesterly on the centerline of Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way approximately 1.76 miles to its intersection with the centerline of Tully Road;
- D. North on the centerline of Tully Road approximately 2.88 miles to its intersection with the centerline of Standiford Avenue;
- E. West on the centerline of Standiford Avenue approximately 1.04 miles to its intersection with the centerline of Prescott Avenue;
- F. North on the centerline of Prescott Avenue approximately 0.10 mile to its intersection with the centerline of the Modesto Irrigation District's Lateral 7;
- G. Northeasterly on said Lateral 7 centerline approximately 0.51 miles to its intersection with the centerline of Snyder Avenue;
- H. West on the centerline of Snyder Avenue approximately 0.26 mile to its intersection with the centerline of Prescott Avenue;
- I. North on the centerline of Prescott Avenue approximately 0.50 miles to its intersection with the centerline of Bangs Avenue;
- J. West on the centerline of Bangs Avenue approximately 0.25 mile to its intersection with the centerline of Morrow Road;

- K. North on the centerline of Morrow Road approximately 0.50 mile to its intersection with the centerline of Kiernan Avenue;
- L. West on the centerline of Kiernan Avenue approximately 0.25 mile to its intersection with the centerline of American Avenue;
- M. North on the centerline of American Avenue approximately 2.05 miles to its intersection with the centerline of the Stanislaus River;
- N. Westerly meandering the centerline of the Stanislaus River downstream approximately 24.5 miles to its junction with the San Joaquin River and the point of beginning of this description.

1.08.050 District No. 4

Supervisorial District No. 4 shall consist of all that territory in Stanislaus County lying within the following described boundaries:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the centerline of the Stanislaus River and the centerline of McHenry Avenue on the section line between Sections 21 and 20, Township 2 South, Range 9 East, Mount Diablo Meridian; thence along the following courses:

- A. Easterly approximately 2.60 miles meandering the centerline of the Stanislaus River upstream and on the Stanislaus-San Joaquin County line to its intersection with the section line between Section 21 and 22, Township 2 South, Range 9 East, Mount Diablo Meridian;
- B. South on the east line of Section 21 and 28, T. 2 S., R. 9 E., Mount Diablo Meridian and the centerline of Coffee Road approximately 4.28 miles to its intersection with the centerline of Sylvan Avenue;
- C.. Easterly approximately 1.00 mile on the centerline of Sylvan Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Oakdale Road;
- D. South approximately 0.75 mile on the centerline of Oakdale Road to its intersection with the centerline of Floyd Avenue;
- E. East on the centerline of Floyd Avenue approximately 1.00 mile to the centerline of Roselle Avenue;
- F. South approximately 1.65 miles on the centerline of Roselle and Lakewood Avenues to their intersection with the centerline of Dry Creek;
- G. Westerly approximately 1.35 miles meandering the centerline of Dry Creek, downstream to its intersection with the centerline of El Vista Avenue;
- H. South on the centerline of El Vista Avenue approximately 1.00 mile to the centerline of Yosemite Boulevard;

- I. South and southeasterly approximately 2.00 miles on centerline of Mitchell Road to its intersection with the centerline of the Tuolumne River;
- J. Meander said centerline of the Tuolumne River westerly downstream approximately 3.32 miles to its intersection with the Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way;
- K. Northerly approximately 1.76 miles on the centerline of Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way to its intersection with the centerline of Tully Road;
- L. North on the centerline of Tully Road approximately 2.88 miles to its intersection with the centerline of Standiford Avenue;
- M. West on the centerline of Standiford Avenue approximately 1.04 miles to its intersection with the centerline of Prescott Avenue;
- N. North on the centerline of Prescott Avenue approximately 0.10 mile to its intersection with the centerline of the Modesto Irrigation District's Lateral 7;
- O. Northeasterly on said Lateral 7 centerline approximately 0.51 mile to its intersection with the centerline of Snyder Avenue;
- P. West on the centerline of Snyder Avenue approximately 0.26 mile to its intersection with the centerline of Prescott Avenue;
- Q. North on the centerline of Prescott Avenue approximately 0.50 mile to its intersection with the centerline of Bangs Avenue;
- R. West on the centerline of Bangs Avenue approximately 0.25 mile to its intersection with the centerline of Morrow Road;
- S. North on the centerline of Morrow Road approximately 0.50 mile to its intersection with the centerline of Kiernan Avenue;
- T. West on the centerline of Kiernan Avenue approximately 0.25 mile to its intersection with the centerline of American Avenue;
- U. North on the centerline of American Avenue approximately 2.05 miles to its intersection with the centerline of the Stanislaus River;
- V. Easterly meandering the centerline of the Stanislaus River upstream approximately 4.00 miles to its intersection with the centerline of McHenry Avenue and the point of beginning of this description.

1.08.060 District No. 5

Supervisorial District No. 5 shall consist of all that territory in Stanislaus County lying within the following described boundaries:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the Stanislaus-San Joaquin County line and the centerline of the San Joaquin River in Section 19, Township 3 South, Range 7 East, Mount Diablo Meridian; thence along the following courses:

- A. Southwesterly approximately 17.5 miles on said county line to its intersection with the Stanislaus-Santa Clara County line on the summit of Mount Boardman in Section 19, Township 5 South, Range 5 East, Mount Diablo Meridian;
- B. Meander said Stanislaus-Santa Clara County line southerly approximately 45.00 miles to its intersection with the Stanislaus-Merced County line in Section 20, Township 9 South, Range 7 East, Mount Diablo Meridian;
- C. Northeasterly approximately 20.00 miles on said Stanislaus-Merced County line to the centerline of the San Joaquin River;
- D. Meander said county line on said centerline of the San Joaquin River northerly downstream approximately 11.50 miles to the centerline of Crows Landing Road;
- E. Northeasterly on the centerline of Crows Landing Road approximately 10.60 miles to the centerline of Service Road;
- F. East approximately 2.67 miles on the centerline of Service Road to its intersection with the centerline of the Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way;
- G. Southeasterly approximately 0.55 miles on the centerline of the Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way to its intersection with the centerline of the Turlock Irrigation district's Ceres Main canal;
- H. Easterly and northerly approximately 2.46 miles on the centerline of said Ceres Main canal to its intersection with the centerline of Hatch Road;
- I. West approximately 0.13 miles on said centerline of Hatch Road to its intersection with the centerline of Mitchell Road;
- J. North approximately 0.53 miles on the centerline of Mitchell Road to its intersection with the centerline of Tuolumne River;
- K. Meander said centerline of Tuolumne River westerly and downstream approximately 17.12 miles to its junction with the centerline of the San Joaquin River;
- L. Meander said centerline of the San Joaquin River northwesterly downstream approximately 8.15 miles to the point of beginning of this description.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from and after the date of its passage and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it shall be published once, with the names of the members voting for and against the same, in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper published in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.

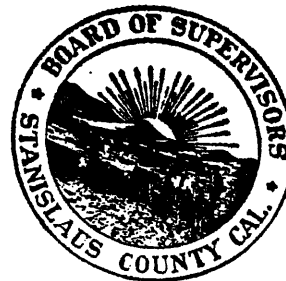



E. North approximately 1.00 mile on the centerline
of El Vista Avenue to its intersection with the cen-
terline of Dry Creek;

F. Easterly approximately 1.35 miles meandering
the centerline of Dry Creek, upstream to its inter-
section with the centerline of Lakewood Avenue;

G. North approximately 1.65 miles on the centerline
of Roselle and Lakewood Avenues to the intersec-

ing Road approximately 10.60 miles to the centerline
of Service Road;

D. East approximately 2.67 miles on the centerline

B. South on the east line of Section 21 and 20, T. 2 S., R. 9 E., Mount Diablo Meridian and the centerline of Coffee Road approximately 4.28 miles to its intersection with the centerline of Sylvan Avenue;

C. Easterly approximately 1.00 mile on the centerline of Sylvan Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Oakdale Road;

D. South approximately 0.75 mile on the centerline of Oakdale Road to its intersection with the centerline of Floyd Avenue;

E. East on the centerline of Floyd Avenue approximately 1.00 mile to the centerline of Roselle Avenue;

F. South approximately 1.65 miles on the centerline of Roselle and Lakewood Avenues to their intersection with the centerline of Dry Creek;

G. Westerly approximately 1.35 miles meandering the centerline of Dry Creek, downstream to its intersection with the centerline of El Vista Avenue;

H. South on the centerline of El Vista Avenue approximately 1.00 mile to the centerline of Yosemite Boulevard;

I. South and southeasterly approximately 2.00 miles on centerline of Mitchell Road to its intersection with the centerline of the Tuolumne River;

J. Meander said centerline of the Tuolumne River westerly downstream approximately 3.32 miles to its intersection with the Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way;

K. Northerly approximately 1.76 miles on the centerline of Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way to its intersection with the centerline of Tully Road;

L. North on the centerline of Tully Road approximately 2.88 miles to its intersection with the centerline of Standiford Avenue;

M. West on the centerline of Standiford Avenue approximately 1.04 miles to its intersection with the centerline of Prescott Avenue;

N. North on the centerline of Prescott Avenue approximately 0.10 mile to its intersection with the
