APPROVAL OF REQUEST TO HOLD A COMMUNITY EVENT AT SALIDA PARK

DISCUSSION: The Department of Parks and Recreation has received a request for the use of Salida Park for a Harvest Festival on Tuesday October 30, 2001. The event will be open to the entire community as a Halloween alternative, which will include such activities as game booths, music, jump houses, and food. There will also be a concert on the baseball field that is on Salida School District property adjacent and part of the park.

The event will be held from 5:30 P.M. and end at 9:30 P.M. The organizers of the event have made arrangements through the Sheriff's Department for an Outdoor Festival permit, and all food booths will have a permit from Environmental Resources for food preparation.

The Salida School District has authorized the use of the baseball field. The event organizers will be responsible to clean all the areas.

The event will be free and open to the entire Salida Community.

The Department of Parks and Recreation requests that the Board approve the staff recommendations.
