

**SUBJECT:** AUTHORIZATION TO APPLY TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES, SEXUALLY-TRANSMITTED DISEASE (STD) CONTROL BRANCH, FOR A GRANT UNDER THE HEALTH OPPORTUNITIES FOR TEENS: SCREENING, PREVENTION, AND TREATMENT OF STDs (HOTSPOTS) PROJECT.

**DISCUSSION:** The California Department of Health Services, Sexually-Transmitted Disease (STD) Control Branch, is inviting applications for an STD control program called Health Opportunities for Teens: Screening, Prevention, and Treatment of STDs (HOTSPOTS). In an effort to decrease chlamydia prevalence among high-risk youth within a community, HOTSPOTS will support local health jurisdictions in the development of innovative community-based chlamydia screening approaches. After selecting up to three local health jurisdictions in California to receive these grants, the STD Control Branch will work with these counties to use surveillance data geo-coding methods to identify high morbidity communities. Using these disease maps, local STD programs will develop community-based outreach methods (e.g., peer educators, community-based organizations, key informants, faith-based organizations) to screen adolescents and young adults for chlamydia within the targeted neighborhoods. Grant funds will provide urine-based diagnostic test kits for chlamydia, medication for treatment of chlamydia (azithromycin) and funds to support administrative, personnel, laboratory, and other project coordination costs.

Through its annual Community Health Reports, HSA has identified chlamydia as one of the leading critical preventable public health issues facing Stanislaus County. Our proposed plan for this project is to tie in with existing collaborations and organizational activities, thereby increasing the ability to sustain community effort for primary STD prevention over time and make certain that the project is implemented within the context of community culture. Initial activities under this grant, if awarded, will include the geocoding of chlamydia data, the targeting of those neighborhoods with the highest prevalence of chlamydia, and the development of community-based strategies to address the issue. Then, at least 800 at-risk youth will receive information regarding STD prevention and opportunities for chlamydia screening and at least 500 at-risk youth will be screened for chlamydia in a community-based non-clinical setting that may include health fairs, youth centers, group homes, and schools.

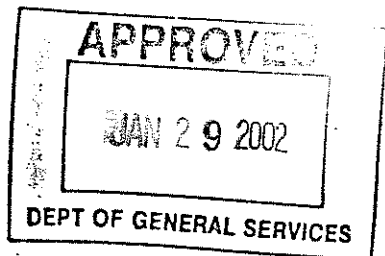
