Louie Arrollo was first elected to City Council on November 5, 1985. On November 3, 1987, he was elected as Mayor. He was re-elected as Mayor on November 7, 1989 and resigned as Mayor on June 11, 1990.

Louie decided to come back to the political scene and on August 24, 1998, was appointed to fill an unexpired term of a Council Member. On November 2, 1999, he was elected as Mayor to a term to expire with the November 6, 2001, election.
