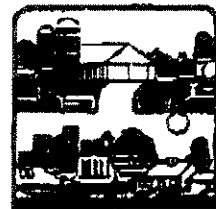
Our nation was founded on values of hard work, faith, family and community. Those values still hold true for farmers and ranchers.
