This is to confirm that a public hearing to receive comment and to consider the Draft Master Plan for Tuolumne River Regional Park and the Master Environmental Impact Report has been scheduled for Wednesday, December 12, at 5:00 p.m. in the Centre Plaza Arbor Theatre, Modesto.

In this precedent-setting meeting all three of the legislative bodies of the Tuolumne River Regional Park Joint Powers Authority will be conducting simultaneous, yet separate, hearings. This is the last step in the approval process for this important project, which has been in the planning process for 20 months.

As we expect a great deal of public interest in the project, there will be a series of public notices, mailers to some 1,500 interested parties, news releases and feature articles over a period of several weeks prior to the meeting.

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Tuolumne River Regional Park Joint Powers Authority (Stanislaus County, City of Ceres, and City of Modesto) has scheduled a joint meeting and public hearing to invite comment and to consider approval of the Draft Tuolumne River Regional Park Master Plan and certification of the Master Environmental Impact Report. The Draft Master Plan will chart the future course of park development along the seven-mile course of the Tuolumne River beginning at Mitchell Road and ending just west of Carpenter Road.

The Draft Master Plan and M.E.I.R. were developed by land use consultant EDAW, Inc., the TRRP Commission, TRRP Citizens Advisory Committee, and staff of the three governing agencies. Input was solicited from public agencies, regulatory bodies, environmental groups and citizens.

All interested persons are invited to attend the public hearing and will be given an opportunity to be heard.

If you challenge the proposed Tuolumne River Regional Park Master Plan in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to one of the City Councils or the Board of Supervisors at, or prior to, the public hearing.
