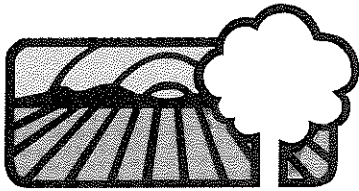

Dear Chair Paul:

After over 24 years of exemplary service with the City of Modesto, Fred Allen, Parks Planning and Development Manager is retiring on December 10, 2001. During Fred's tenure with the City, 14 park sites have been acquired, and 30 have been partially or fully developed. This impressive list is due in large part to Fred's enthusiasm, his dedication and his ability to manage capital improvement and grant funds.

Fred has also been instrumental in development of the community workshop design process, which is now used routinely for neighborhood and community park development. It has also been a highly effective tool in the Tuolumne River Regional Park Master Plan and Regional Sports Facility Study processes. Fred has also built the Park Partners Program into a very successful and active method of uniting community interest and "sweat equity" with municipal funding.
