SUBJECT: APPROVAL TO INTRODUCE AND WAIVE THE FIRST READING OF AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 11 OF THE STANISLAUS COUNTY CODE, ADDING A TWO HOUR PARKING ZONE ON MAUD AVENUE; NO PARKING ZONES ON VARIOUS COUNTY ROADS; AND, REPEALING NO PARKING ZONES ON CROWS LANDING ROAD

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. FIND THAT THE SUBJECT ORDINANCE IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE, SECTIONS 2100 ET SEQ.); AND,
2. INTRODUCE, APPROVE, AND WAIVE THE FIRST READING OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11 OF THE STANISLAUS COUNTY CODE, SECTION 11.08.060 TO ADD A TWO HOUR PARKING ZONE ON MAUD AVENUE; SECTION 11.08.020 TO ADD NO PARKING ZONES ON VARIOUS COUNTY ROADS; AND, TO REPEAL NO PARKING ZONES ON CROWS LANDING ROAD.

FISCAL IMPACT: There will be a cost of \$75.00 per sign installation that will be taken out of the Road Fund.

SUBJECT: APPROVAL TO INTRODUCE AND WAIVE THE FIRST READING OF AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 11 OF THE STANISLAUS COUNTY CODE, ADDING A TWO HOUR PARKING ZONE ON MAUD AVENUE; NO PARKING ZONES ON VARIOUS COUNTY ROADS; AND, REPEALING NO PARKING ZONES ON CROWS LANDING ROAD

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DISCUSSION: A two hour parking zone on the south east side of Maud Avenue in Keyes was the result of a request by the adjacent library. The parking in this area is labeled for library use only and is often occupied by employees of a nearby school. This two hour parking zone will aid the library by allowing the patrons to park in the designated spots.

A No Parking Zone on Tenaya Drive was requested by the Food Processors Credit Union, the sole business on that side of the street in the immediate area. Vehicles parked adjacent to the driveways restrict the sight visibility and cause an undue hazard. Parking is available offstreet and onstreet.

No Parking Zones on School Avenue and Crows Landing Road were necessary to improve sight visibility and to improve the operation of the traffic signal at the intersection of those two roads. The no parking zones described for Crows Landing Road was a combination of several existing zones and therefore required the repealing of several existing subsections to the County Code.

A No Parking Zone on Grayson Road was necessary to improve sight visibility, vehicles parked adjacent to the driveways restricted the visibility and caused an undue hazard. Parking is available offstreet.

The proposed ordinance has the recommendation of this Department and approval as to form from County Counsel. Therefore, it is recommended that you introduce the ordinance and waive the reading thereof.

POLICY

ISSUE: This action is consistent with the Board's policy of providing a safe, healthy community.

STAFFING

IMPACT: There is no staffing impact associated with this action.

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ORDINANCE NO. C.S. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
TWO HOUR PARKING ZONES, AND
NO PARKING ZONES ON VARIOUS COUNTY ROADS

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS ORDAINS AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 11.08.060 (Two Hour Parking Zone) of the Stanislaus County Code is hereby amended by adding Subsection 6 (Maud Avenue) to read as follows:

“6. Maud Avenue. On the southerly side of Maud Avenue from its intersection thereof with 9th Street westerly to a point 140 feet from said intersection.”

Section 2. Section 11.08.020. (No Parking At Any Time) of the Stanislaus County Code is hereby amended to add subsection 459 (Tenaya Drive), subsection 460 (School Avenue), subsection 461 (Grayson Road), and subsection 462 (Crows Landing Road) to read as follows:

“459. Tenaya Drive. On the westerly side of Tenaya Drive from a point 580 feet northerly of its intersection with Riverside Drive northerly 86 feet to point 666 feet northerly of said intersection; and, on the westerly side of Tenaya Drive from a point 695 feet northerly of its intersection with Riverside Drive, northerly 83 feet to a point 778 feet northerly of said intersection.

“460. School Avenue. On the north and south side of School Avenue from its intersection thereof with Crows Landing Road, east to point 100 feet from said intersection.

“461. Grayson Road. On the north and south side of Grayson Road from its intersection thereof with Crows Landing Road, east to a point 800 feet from of said intersection.

“462. Crows Landing Road. On the east side of Crows Landing Road from a point 159 feet south of its intersection thereof with Barozzi Avenue, north to a point 175 feet north of its intersection thereof with School Avenue; and, on the west side of Crows Landing Road from its intersection thereof with Hatch Road, north to a point 220 feet north of its intersection thereof with School Avenue.”

Section 3. Section 11.08.020. (No Parking At Any Time) of the Stanislaus County Code is hereby amended to repeal subsection 25 (Crows Landing Road), subsection 28 (Crows Landing Road), and subsection 30 (Crows Landing Road).

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days from and after the date of its passage, and before the expiration of 15 days after its passage, it shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.


