Land Conservation Plan Available Public Review

Dear Stakeholder:

The Stewardship Council is pleased to the release of the draft Land Conservation Plan to guide the conservation, ownership, and management of more than 140,000 acres of Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) watershed lands in perpetuity. The Land Conservation Plan is available for public review and comment from June 18- August 21, 2007. You are receiving a copy of the Land Conservation Plan because you are listed in the Council's database. Instructions regarding how to review and submit comments, along with an electronic comment form, are included on the CD-ROM in this package. Additionally, we are including a list of public buildings where a hardcopy of the Land Conservation Plan is on display. The Land Conservation Plan is also available on the Council's website at <http://lcp.stewardshipcouncil.org>.

The Land Conservation Plan is designed as a three-volume set. Volume I provides background on the land planning analysis conducted to date, and addresses compliance with legal requirements governing the work of the Stewardship Council. Volume II provides maps and reports that depict conceptual plans and potential recommendations for how the Beneficial Public Values can be preserved and enhanced on the watershed lands.

Implementation of the Land Conservation Plan will be the subject of Volume III, which will focus on land disposition and assignment of specific conservation easements for the parcels. This Volume will be prepared over several years, and will be assembled in increments as specific parcels of land are ready for conveyance to public entities and/or qualified non-profit organizations. The Stewardship Council looks forward to working with the public as the planning process for Volume III evolves.

The Stewardship Council is hosting a series of community meetings to orient the public to Volumes I & II, and to explain how to submit comments. Meeting dates and locations are listed in the enclosed materials and posted on our website at www.stewardshipcouncil.org. We strongly encourage you to participate in the review and comment process.

The Stewardship Council requests that individuals utilize the electronic feedback form on the CD-ROM or comment directly through our website. However, the Council is interested in hearing from all stakeholders and written comments can be mailed to the Stewardship Council at the address below.

All of us at the Stewardship Council look forward to hearing from you as we continue to develop the Land Conservation Plan.
