Approval to Introduce and Waive the First Reading of an Ordinance to Amend Section 11.04.050 of the Stanislaus County Code by Adding a 40 Miles-Per-Hour Speed Zone on Blossom Road in the Waterford Area

DISCUSSION:

A request was received by adjacent property owners requesting a speed study on Blossom Road south of Yosemite Boulevard (State Route 132). The results of the traffic study performed on Blossom Road, between Yosemite Boulevard and Pellerin Road, shows that the 40 Miles-Per-Hour Speed Zone is appropriate on this section of Blossom Road. The current speed for this section of roadway is 55 Miles-Per-Hour. Due to the condition and the narrow width of the road, along with the traffic study, the Department of Public Works staff recommends that the 40 Miles-Per-Hour Speed Zone be installed to inform drivers of the appropriate speed for this roadway and help alleviate any safety issues.

The specific descriptions of the proposed amendments are identified and provided in the text of the proposed ordinance.

POLICY ISSUES:

The Board should consider if the recommended actions are consistent with the Board's priorities of providing a safe and healthy community.

STAFFING IMPACT:

There is no staffing impact associated with this item.

ORDINANCE NO. C.S. _____

AN ORDINANCE ADDING A 40 MILES-PER-HOUR SPEED ZONE
ON BLOSSOM ROAD (WATERFORD AREA)

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Stanislaus ordains as follows:

Section 1 Section 11.04.050 (40 miles-per-hour) of the Stanislaus County Code is hereby amended to add Subsection 95 (Blossom Road) to read as follows:

“95. Blossom Road. On Blossom Road from its intersection thereof with Yosemite Boulevard (State Route 132) south to its intersection with Pellerin Road.”

Section 2 This ordinance shall take effect 30 days from and after the date of its passage, and before the expiration of 15 days after its passage, it shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.



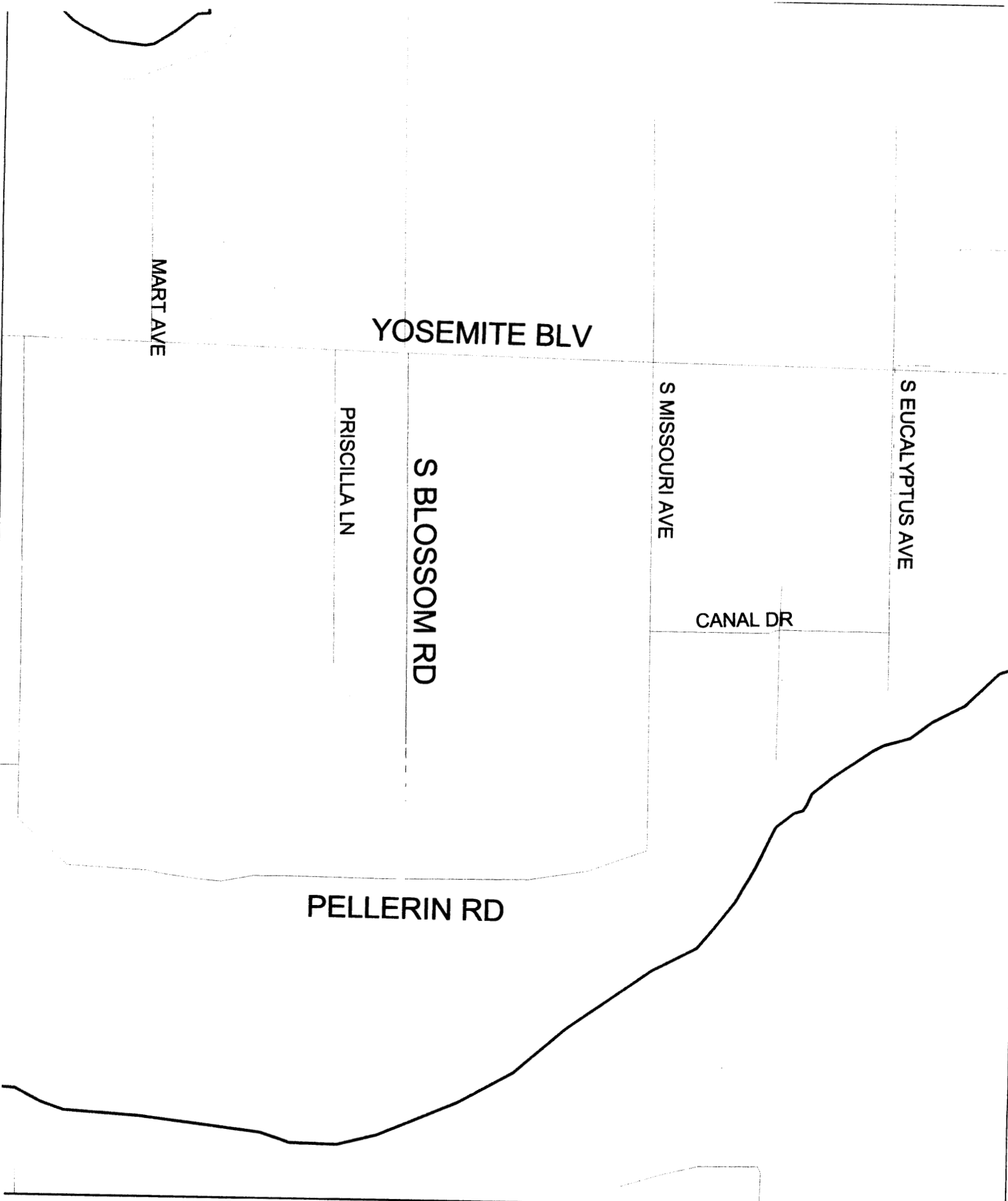

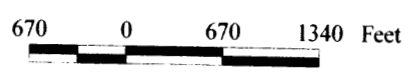
