The Department does not have any concerns or objections to this request, including the waiver of fees. We do require:

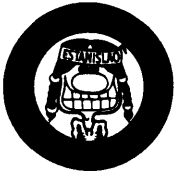

*E Clampus Vitus, a historical preservation group is requesting the use of the La Grange Gold Dredge Camp (Kiwanis), located off of Highway 132, La Grange, California for our Fall Event. We have been in contact with the Parks Department and it appears that there are no other events scheduled at this site for our dates (10/17 through 10/19).*

*We will present the necessary insurance coverage naming Stanislaus County as the co-insured on a one million-dollar policy. E Clampus Vitus is a non-profit organization; therefore, we are requesting a waiver of the customary fees.*
