

OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT IN REVIEW OF ESA-PROTECTED SPECIES

As part of its 5-year review of some species currently protected under the federal Endangered Species Act, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS) is requesting information from the public.

The public is encouraged to submit, by May 5, 2008, any new information about any species under review.

Species under review in the Sacramento Fish and Wildlife Office are: **Animals** (7): bay checkerspot butterfly, callippe silverspot butterfly, mission blue butterfly, Myrtle's silverspot butterfly, San Bruno elfin butterfly, salt marsh harvest mouse, Shasta crayfish; **Plants** (14): Calistoga allocarya, Clara Hunt's milk-vetch, clover lupine, fleshy owl's-clover, Ione buckwheat (including Irish Hill), Ione manzanita, Kenwood Marsh checkermallow, large-flowered fiddleneck, Napa bluegrass, Pitkin Marsh lily, Tiburon jewelflower, Tiburon mariposa lily, Tiburon paintbrush and white sedge.
