SUBJECT: REQUEST FROM THE GREATER YOSEMITE COUNCIL, BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA FOR THE USE OF WOODWARD RESERVOIR – AREA T

Attached please find a request from the GREATER YOSEMITE COUNCIL, BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA (GROUP) to utilize Woodward Reservoir and its Area T for their weekend camping event from 3:00 p.m. on Friday, May 2, 2008 through 12:00 p.m. Noon, on Sunday, May 4, 2008.

The Department does not have any objections to this request and recommends the Board to approve the request as follows:

- By Tuesday, April 29, 2008, no later than 3:00 p.m., require the Greater Yosemite Council, Boy Scouts of America to provide the Department of Parks and Recreation, Attention Margarita D. Ramos, Deputy Director, its Certificate of Insurance with a minimum general liability of \$1 million and the Endorsement naming Stanislaus County as an additional insured.
- By Tuesday, April 29, 2008, no later than 3:00 p.m., require the Hold Harmless Agreement (Organization) to be completed and returned to the Department of Parks and Recreation, Attn: Margarita D. Ramos, Deputy Director.
- The expected number of person for this event is 200 youth and 50 adults.
- Exclusive Use Fees and Vehicle Entrance Fees are waived.
- There is an Administrative Fee of \$10 for this Exclusive Use Event.
- There is a flat rate fee of \$500 for the GROUP event.
- The total fees for the Greater Yosemite Council Boy Scouts of America camping event is \$510. By Tuesday, April 29, 2008, no later than 3:00 p.m. require the Greater Yosemite Council, Boy Scouts of America to provide the Department of Parks and Recreation payment for their GROUP Exclusive Use camping event.
- No alcohol is to be sold or served during the GROUP event.
- The area is to be left in a clean condition.

- If portable toilets are brought in by the GROUP, they shall be placed in areas as directed by your contact person.

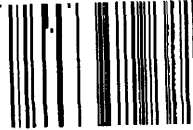


We would like to have a weekend camping event for the Boy Scouts of America-Greater Yosemite Council of Modesto-at Woodward Reservoir. The details are as follows:
