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Re: NOTIFICATION OF PLANT CLOSING


Dear Mr. Monteith:

The federal Worker Adjustment Retraining and Notification Act ("WARN") and California law require that notice of certain mass layoffs, plant closings, relocations, and terminations be provided to the Employment Development Department ("EDD") and certain government entities. The purpose of this letter is to notify you that Indalex, Inc. will close its entire Modesto facility, which is located at 4555 North Star Way, Modesto, CA 95356. All of the employees at this facility will be separated from the company pursuant to this plant closing. The first separations are expected to occur during the 14-day period beginning on June 24, 2008. This action is expected to be permanent.

A list of the names of employees who will be affected, their job titles, their anticipated separation dates, the number of employees in each job title, and information regarding union representatives and bumping rights is attached.
