**SUBJECT: REQUEST FROM CROWS LANDING LIONS CLUB FOR THE USE OF
CROWS LANDING – BONITA POOL**

The Department has received a request from the Crows Landing Lions Club (GROUP) to utilize the Crows Landing – Bonita Pool for their End of the Year Pool Party for children of the community who have participated in the baseball/softball program. The facility is requested for use on Thursday, June 12, 2008, between the hours of 6:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m.

The Department does not have any objections and recommends the Board to approve the request as follows:

- By Wednesday, June 11, 2008, no later than 3:00 p.m., require the GROUP to provide the Department of Parks and Recreation, Attention Margarita D. Ramos, Deputy Director, its Certificate of Insurance with a minimum general liability of \$1 million and the Endorsement naming Stanislaus County as an additional insured.
- By Wednesday, June 11, 2008, no later than 3:00 p.m., require the GROUP to have completed and returned the Hold Harmless Agreement to the Department of Parks and Recreation, Attn: Margarita D. Ramos, Deputy Director.
- The expected number of persons for this event is 50.
- Exclusive Use Fees in the amount \$90 is waived
- Administrative/Reservation Fees of \$10 is waived.
- Stanislaus County Police Activity League will provide lifeguarding services.
- Stanislaus County Police Activity league will serve as the on-site coordinator designee during this event on behalf of the Department and will ensure the facility is prepped prior to GROUP event.
- Stanislaus County Police Activity League will ensure the facility is secured and locked prior to leaving the facility.
- No alcohol is to be sold or served during the GROUP program.
- The area is to be left in a clean condition as determined by the on-site coordinator designee.
