Approval and Acceptance of the Subdivision Improvements for Vesting Tentative Parcel Map 2001-04 Hillsborough Estates Subdivision Unit No. 2 (East Oakdale Area)

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Find that all subdivision improvements required for the Hillsborough II Estates Subdivision by the Subdivision Improvement Agreement, executed by Stanislaus Development LLC and the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors, on June 5, 2007 have been constructed to the satisfaction of Stanislaus County.
2. Find that the said agreement was recorded on June 8, 2007, as Document No. 2007-0076772-00, and filed with the Stanislaus County Clerk and Records Office.

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FISCAL IMPACT:

The maintenance of the public roads will be the fiscal responsibility of the Public Works Department. The ongoing maintenance costs of the storm drainage system, including the river outfall facility, will be funded by County Service Area No. 23.

Acceptance of the Subdivision Improvements for Vesting Tentative Parcel Map 2001-04 Hillsborough Estates Subdivision Unit No. 2 (East Oakdale Area)

3. Accept all roads, highways, avenues, drainage system and all other street dedications.

DISCUSSION:

Hillsborough Estates Subdivision Unit No. 2 is a 66-lot residential subdivision located on Foxborough Drive in east Oakdale. The Final Map was approved and filed pursuant to Resolution No. 2007-445, approved by the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors on June 5, 2007. All on-site improvements in the subdivision required by the Subdivision Improvement Agreement have been constructed to Stanislaus County Standards. These improvements were installed prior to the Final Map being recorded. The Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Resolution 2008-321, accepted the off-site improvements May 6, 2008.

The 20,000 square foot minimum lots within the subdivision will be served with public water by Oakdale Irrigation District. An aerobic sewage disposal system will be installed on each individual lot, as development occurs. The subdivision's storm drain system includes an outfall facility to discharge storm runoff into the Stanislaus River. County Service Area No. 23 - Hillsborough-Schutz, has been formed to provide a funding mechanism to pay for the ongoing maintenance of the storm drain facilities including the outfall facility.

POLICY ISSUES:

The Board should consider if the recommended actions are consistent with the Board's priorities of providing a safe and healthy community.

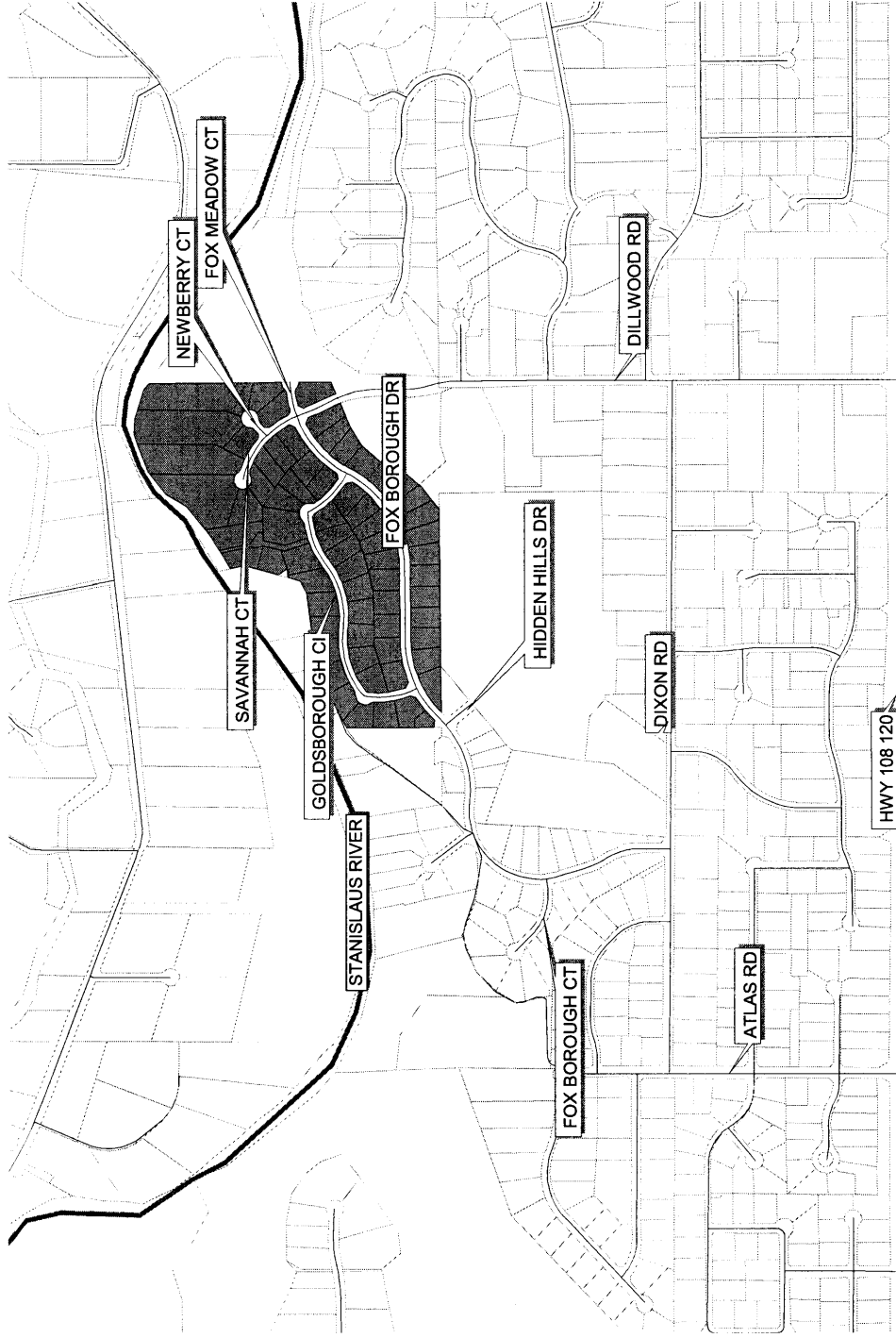
STAFFING IMPACT:
