Approval for Boy Scout Troop No. 43 to have Exclusive Use of the Kiwanis Camp from November 7, 2008 to November 9, 2008 for Overnight Camping Activities and Waiver of Fees for the Exclusive Use

DISCUSSION:

A request has been received from Boy Scout Troop No. 43 to have exclusive use of the Kiwanis Camp from Friday, November 7, 2008, beginning at 2:00 p.m. to Sunday, November 9, 2008, ending at 2:00 p.m. for their overnight camping activities.

The 50-acre Kiwanis Camp is located near the town of La Grange, south of Basso Bridge, east of Lake Road, and across the street from the Basso Bridge Fishing Access Area. The Camp was established in 1980 by the Kiwanis Club of Greater Modesto and is located adjacent to remnants of the historic gold dredge camp and the Joe Domecq Wildlife Area.

The Department of Parks and Recreation does not have any objections to this request for exclusive use and as such necessitates Boy Scout Troop No. 43 to adhere to the following requirements:

- By Thursday, November 6, 2008, no later than 3:00 p.m., require Boy Scout Troop No. 43, to provide the Department of Parks and Recreation its Certificate of Insurance with a minimum general liability of \$1 million and endorsement naming Stanislaus County as an additional insured.
- A Hold Harmless Agreement (Organization) is required. The original agreement must be completed and returned by Thursday, November 6, 2008, no later than 3:00 p.m.
- Hold Harmless Agreements (Individual) are required. The original agreement must be completed and returned upon return of the key but no later than Wednesday, November 12, 2008.
- A security key deposit of \$50 is waived.
- The expected number of participants for this event is 15 youth and 15 adults.
- No alcohol shall be sold, served, or consumed during this exclusive use.
- The areas are to be left in a clean condition as discussed in the Kiwanis Camp Handbook.

POLICY ISSUE:

The Board should consider whether the approval of this exclusive use request and waiver of fees supports the Board of Supervisors' priority of effective partnerships with youth organizations that serve and provide valued recreational experiences.

STAFFING IMPACT:

There are no staffing impacts associated with this item.
