SUBJECT:

Approval to Introduce and Waive the First Reading of an Ordinance to Amend Section 11.08.040 of the Stanislaus County Code, Amending Green Curb Markings on Maud Avenue in the Keyes Area; and, Section 11.08.110 of the Stanislaus County Code, Amending Blue Curb Markings on Elm Street in the Denair Area

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Find that the subject ordinance is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code, Sections 2100 et. seq.).
2. Introduce and waive the first reading of an ordinance to amend Section 11.08.040 of the Stanislaus County Code, amending green curb markings on Maud Avenue in the Keyes area; and, Section 11.08.110 of the Stanislaus County Code, amending blue curb markings on Elm Street in the Denair Area.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The cost to provide and install 20 lineal feet of green paint and 40 lineal feet of blue paint for curb marking at the noted locations is \$3 per lineal foot for an estimated cost of \$180. The cost to provide and install 4 signs at the noted locations is \$250 per installation for an estimated cost of \$1,000. Total estimated cost for complete installation is \$1,180. Funding is to be provided by Public Works' Road Fund and is available in the current budget.

Approval to Introduce and Waive the First Reading of an Ordinance to Amend Section 11.08.040 of the Stanislaus County Code, Amending Green Curb Markings on Maud Avenue in the Keyes Area; and, Section 11.08.110 of the Stanislaus County Code, Amending Blue Curb Markings on Elm Street in the Denair Area

DISCUSSION:

The Department of Public Works has received several requests for the installation of green curb markings and blue curb markings in the Keyes and Denair areas.

Maud Avenue (Keyes Area): The Superintendent of the Keyes Union School District requested green curb markings at designated parking stalls on Maud Avenue. Vehicles parking in these stalls will have limited time parking for the purpose of allowing more visitors to the District office.

Elm Street (Denair Area): The Principal of the Denair Elementary School on Elm Street received a request from a parent of a handicapped student to install a blue curb marking space. The handicap space will allow the parent to park directly in front of the school walkway.

The Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering staff has studied and field reviewed each location. The Department recommends that green curb markings and blue curb markings be installed at these locations to help alleviate these traffic safety issues.

The specific description of the proposed amendment is identified and provided in the text of the proposed ordinance.

POLICY ISSUES:

The Board of Supervisors is asked to determine if this action is consistent with its priorities of providing a safe community, a healthy community, and a well-planned infrastructure system. California Vehicles Code 22506 requires Board approval to change parking zones.

STAFFING IMPACT:

There is no staffing impact associated with this item.

ORDINANCE NO. C.S. _____

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 11.08.040
GREEN CURB MARKING ON MAUD AVENUE (KEYES AREA); AND,
AMENDING SECTION 11.08.110
BLUE CURB MARKING ON ELM STREET (DENAIR AREA)

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Stanislaus ordains as follows:

Section 1 Section 11.08.040 (Green curb marking) of the Stanislaus County Code is hereby to amend subsection 7 (Maud Avenue) to read as follows:

“7. Maud Avenue. On the south side of Maud Avenue from its intersection thereof with Eighth Street to a point 94 feet east of the intersection and, on the south side of Maud Avenue from its intersection thereof with Eighth Street to a point 66 feet west of the intersection.”

Section 2 Section 11.08.110 (Blue curb marking) of the Stanislaus County Code is hereby to amend subsection (Elm Street) to read as follows:

“10. Elm Street. On the north side of Elm Street from a point 40 feet easterly of its intersection thereof with Fresno Avenue easterly 40 feet to a point 80 feet easterly of the intersection.”



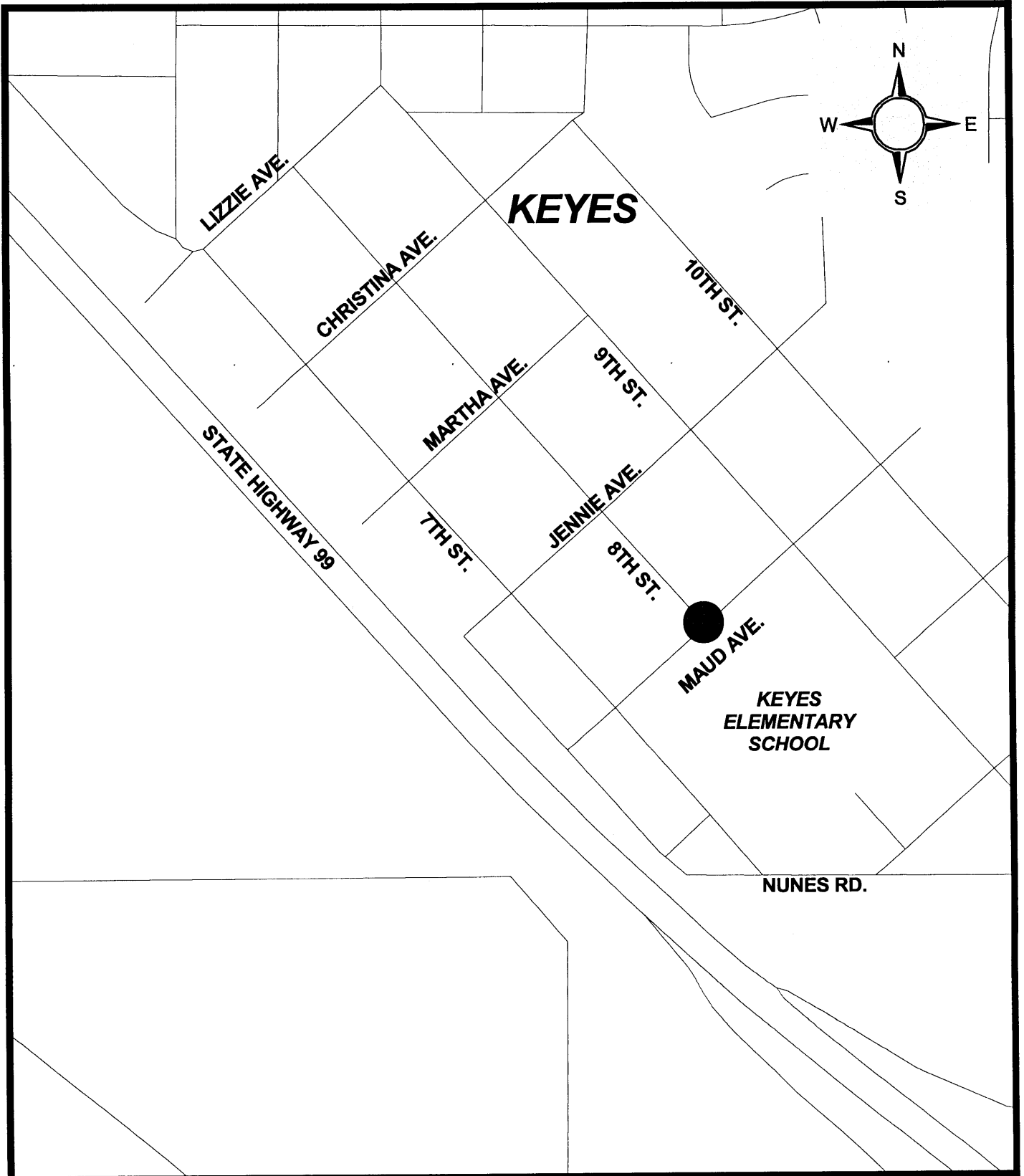
