STANISLAUS ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND WORKFORCE ALLIANCE

CONSENT ITEM A: Approval of New Terms for Youth Advisory Council Members:

DISCUSSION: The Workforce Investment Act (WIA) mandates that each local area have a Youth Advisory Council responsible for overseeing youth employment and training activities. The Youth Advisory Council currently has 3 members whose terms are due to expire at the end of December 2008. Each of these members covers an area that is required to be represented on the Youth Advisory Council.

These new terms would be for 2 years, and would expire on December 31, 2010. Approval of the new terms would also maintain their status of non-voting members of the Alliance Board for the same time period.

This item was discussed at the 12/8/08 Youth Advisory Council meeting. No official action was taken, due to a lack of a quorum. The discussion among the members who were present was supportive of renewing the terms for these 3 members.

Per WIA requirements, approvals will be forwarded to the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors for ratification.
