The total estimated cost for this project is \$1,183,500. The project will be funded by federal and local funds. Local funds are available in the Public Works Road fund. Approval to Adopt Plans and Specifications for the Shiloh Road Bridge at Tuolumne River and Set the Bid Opening Date and Time for May 20, 2009 at 2:30 P.M.

4. Direct the Public Works Department staff to mail a notice inviting bids to trade journals as required by law.

DISCUSSION:

The Shiloh Road Bridge at Tuolumne River project is for the seismic retrofit of the Shiloh Road Bridge at the Tuolumne River which includes the installation of three (3) sets of two (2) cast-in-steel shell concrete piles (each approximately 5 feet in diameter) and the installation of a longer hinge extension beneath the bridge deck.

In August 2003, the design was complete and ready for bidding and on August 26, 2003, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) issued an E-76 for \$718,820 for the project construction phase.

In January 2004, the Shiloh Road Bridge at Tuolumne River project design was suspended pending availability of local match funding.

In November 2006, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) determined that the environmental phase required renewal due to more rigorous air quality and hazardous materials regulations.

In February 2008, County staff re-initiated this project to start the environmental process and to update the plans to current Caltrans and County and standards.

On November 4, 2008, Caltrans issued a National Environment Policy Act Categorical Exclusion determination for the project.

Dokken Engineering has completed the plans and specifications for the Shiloh Road Bridge at Tuolumne River project. All environmental permits and right-of-way agreements have been obtained or are currently in the process of being renewed. The Department of Public Works staff recommends that the Board of Supervisors adopt the plans and specifications and set the bid opening date.

Approval to Adopt Plans and Specifications for the Shiloh Road Bridge at Tuolumne River and Set the Bid Opening Date and Time for May 6, 2009 at 2:00 P.M.

This project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Class 2, Section 15302 (Replace/Reconstruct) of the California Code of Regulations. On December 30, 2008, Stanislaus County issued a California Environmental Quality Act Categorical Exemption determination for the project.
