

Also enclosed is a check in the amount of \$13,109.80 to cover the Petitions' fees.

Each of the water right holders identified above are shareholders within PGV. PGV holds a Sacramento River Settlement Contract with the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation, for which the above water rights form a portion of the base supply under the Contract. For this reason, the Petitions are being filed jointly and a single check in the amount of \$850 to cover the fee for the Department of Fish and Game is enclosed, consistent with Public Resources Code Section 10005(e).

The shareholders of PGV listed above are petitioning to temporarily add points of diversion, places of use, and purposes of use in order to transfer up to a total of 7,300 AF to the Department of Water Resources' (DWR) 2009 Drought Water Bank (DWB) by crop idling, crop


