Approval for Living Water Bible Church to Have Exclusive Use of the Wincanton Park, Pavilion Area on Sunday, July 5, 2009 for their 17th Anniversary Celebration and Picnic

DISCUSSION

A request has been received from Living Water Bible Church to have exclusive use of the Wincanton Park, Pavilion Area located in Salida on Sunday, July 5, 2009, beginning at 4:00 p.m. and ending at 8:30 p.m. for their 17th Anniversary Celebration and Picnic.

Access to the basketball court, playground, and open turf areas will be shared, as this event is a community event open to the public.

Living Water Bible Church is a non-denominational fellowship emphasizing worship, personal leadership, and acceptance of humanity as it is. The vision of Living Water Bible Church is *"learning to live a greater life and enrich the community."*

The Department of Parks and Recreation does not have any objection to this request for exclusive use and as such necessities Living Water Bible Church to adhere to the following requirements:

- By Thursday, July 2, 2009, no later than 5:00 p.m. require Living Water Bible Church, to provide the Department of Parks and Recreation a Certificate of Insurance with a minimum general liability of \$1 million and endorsement naming Stanislaus County as an additional insured.
- The exclusive use and reservation fees of \$100 is payable by Thursday, July 2, 2009, no later than 5:00 p.m.
- A Hold Harmless Agreement (Organization) is required. The original agreement must be completed and returned by Thursday, July 2, 2009, no later than 5:00 p.m.
- The expected number of participants is 75 adults and children.
- No alcohol may be sold, served, or consumed during this exclusive use.
- Portable restrooms are not to be placed on turf.
- The Department does not guarantee electricity at the facility.
- The Department will ensure irrigation does not interfere with this exclusive use.
- The Department does not guarantee the facility will be clear of garbage or debris.
- The Department does recommend Living Water Bible Church post signs earlier in the day to allow park patrons the opportunity to vacate the pavilion area.

POLICY ISSUE (S)

The Board should consider whether the approval of this exclusive use request and fees supports the Board of Supervisors' priority of effective partnerships.
