TANC Transmission Project (TTP) EIR/EIS Public Scoping Comment Period Extended to July 30, 2009

In response to your requests for additional time to submit scoping comments on the proposed Transmission Agency of Northern California (TANC) Transmission Project, TANC and Western Area Power Administration (Western) have further extended the scoping comment period by 60 days. The public scoping comment period for the TTP Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Impact Statement (EIR/EIS) will now close on July 30, 2009.

The TANC Transmission Project (TTP) is a proposal to build and upgrade approximately 600 miles of high-voltage electric transmission lines and substations in northern California to increase reliability, reduce congestion, and facilitate the development and transmission of renewable electricity in Northern California.
