

Approval for Soul Harvest Worship Center to Have Exclusive Use of Salida Park on August 29, 2009, for their Community Event

DISCUSSION:

A request has been received from Soul Harvest Worship Center to have exclusive use of Salida Park on Saturday, August 29, 2009 beginning at 9:00 a.m. and ending no later than 6:00 p.m. for their Community Event.

This event is new to the community. Due to economic hardship that families are facing, the event is meant to prepare children, youth, and families with items needed to be ready start school.

Soul Harvest Worship Center is headquartered in Modesto. Its purpose is to be identified by its commitment to the community, building strong relationships with those in the community, and supporting its community through many challenges.

The Department of Parks and Recreation does not have any objections to this request for exclusive use and as such necessitates Soul Harvest Worship Center to adhere to the following requirements:

- Soul Harvest Worship Center shall work with other necessary groups, organizations, or other governmental personnel as determined by applicable codes, laws, and regulation to ensure a safe event.
- By Wednesday, August 26, 2009, no later than 5:00 p.m. require Soul Harvest Worship Center, to provide the Department of Parks and Recreation a Certificate of Insurance with minimum general liability coverage of \$1 million and endorsement naming Stanislaus County as an additional insured.
- A Hold Harmless Agreement (Organization) is required. The original agreement must be completed and returned by Wednesday, August 26, 2009, no later than 5:00 p.m.
- This community event is open to the public and the expected number of community members is less than 100 persons.
- Alcohol may not be sold, served, or consumed on County property during this exclusive use.
- The area is to be left in a clean condition with all waste, debris, and garbage removed from County premises upon conclusion of this exclusive use event.
- No vehicles may be driven on the Salida Park turf.
- Portable restrooms shall not be placed on Salida Park turf.

POLICY ISSUE (S):

The Board should consider whether the approval of this exclusive use request and waiver of fees supports the Board of Supervisors' priority of effective partnerships. The Department of Parks and Recreation strives to establish partnerships with organizations that strengthen community image and sense of place through use of outdoor open spaces that facilitate community connections.
