For your information the Community Redevelopment Agency of the City of Newman is providing this courtesy notice advising you that the Agency is in the process of preparing the proposed "2010 Amendment" to the redevelopment plan for the Newman Redevelopment Project. The purpose of the 2010 Amendment is predominantly fiscal in nature and its objectives are to: increase the Plan's total tax increment allocation limit, eliminate the Plan's annual limitation on tax increment allocation, establish a bonded indebtedness limit, and modify the Plan's projects and programs list as may be necessary. Achieving these objectives will help the Agency to better its long-term goal to improve or alleviate the economic and physical conditions of blight within the Project Area.

As required by law, other information, including the date of the Agency/City Council joint public hearing on the 2010 Amendment and related environmental documents, will be provided to your Agency at the appropriate time in the plan amendment process.
