Approval to Declare One County Vehicle Purchased by California Multi-Jurisdictional Methamphetamine Enforcement Team (Cal-MMET) Surplus and Authorize Sale of This Vehicle

DISCUSSION:

The purpose of this agenda item is to receive authority to declare one Sheriff's Department undercover vehicle as surplus, and authorize its sale. This vehicle was purchased with Cal-MMET grant funding and became the property of the Stanislaus County Sheriff's Department.

Cal-MMET is now in its ninth year of working towards the goal of eliminating drug traffickers and enforcing drug laws. Cal-MMET works very closely with the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) task force and the Stanislaus Drug Enforcement Agency. This vehicle was purchased by the Cal-MMET program and is now high mileage, in need of repair, and has outlived its usefulness to the efforts of Cal-MMET. The vehicle to be auctioned follows:

The auction company will sell this vehicle. Auction costs will be deducted from the proceeds. An estimate of \$1,000 for this vehicle was based off of sales of similar vehicles. Upon receipt of these funds they should be placed in the Sheriff's Department Cal-MMET Fund 1780.0028886.46000 to be used by Cal-MMET for the purchase of equipment in the future.
