FISCAL IMPACT:

The total anticipated cost for this project is \$3,820,475. The project is funded \$3,382,267 (88.53%) from Federal Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) funds and \$438,208 (11.47%) from County Roads funds. The Department anticipates using Proposition 42 funds to provide the local match portion.

Approval to Adopt Plans and Specifications for the RSTP 2009 Cape Seal Project, Federal Project No. STPL-5938(168) and Set the Bid Opening Date

DISCUSSION:

The RSTP 2009 Cape Seal will consist of a Type II Slurry Seal over a 3/8 inch Polymer Modified Chip Seal. The Cape Seal will be placed over approximately 52 miles of road surfaces creating a smooth, durable, water resistant pavement surface. In addition to the 52 miles of base roads, there are six (6) alternate roads that total an additional 14 miles. If the winning bid for the base roads is below the anticipated cost, then roads from the alternate road list can be added to the contract to utilize any excess funding. New striping will be applied on the centerline and edge lines as well as various pavement markings.

All preliminary engineering was done in-house by Public Works staff.

The following roads are included in the program:

Base Roads

1. La Grange Road (Yosemite Blvd to Merced County Line)
2. Lake Road (Hickman Road to Yosemite Blvd)
3. Santa Fe Ave (7Th Street to Stanislaus County Line)
4. Montpelier Road (Lake Road to Turlock Irrigation District Highline Canal)
5. East Ave (Daubenberger Road to Stanislaus County Line)
6. Hickman Road (Whitmore Ave to Tuolumne River Bridge)
7. Whitmore Ave (Euclid Ave to Hickman Road)
8. Keyes Road (Montpelier Road to Merced County Line)

Alternate Roads

1. Geer Road (Taylor Road to Santa Fe Ave)
2. Gratton Road (East Ave to Mt. Bullion)
3. Monte Vista Ave (Santa Fe Ave to Hickman Road)
4. Hickman Road (Monte Vista Ave to East Ave)
5. Keyes Road (Santa Fe Ave to Hickman Road)
6. Gratton Road (Keyes Road to Whitmore Ave)

This project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act, Class 1, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, #15301 (Existing Facilities).

The project is anticipated to begin construction on May 17, 2010 and be completed by August 27, 2010.
