In 2003 the City of Waterford was fortunate enough to obtain a grant for River Front Parkland acquisition. Several years ago we purchased one parcel and have been negotiating on APN 080-035-009 since we obtained this grant. It finally looks like we might be closing on the property soon. A requirement of this grant is to make sure we have notified the County Board of Supervisors, adjacent property owners, affected water districts and other interested parties. This parcel is intended to be used for passive use parkland to provide an opportunity for our mutual citizens to enjoy the many natural and cultural attributes of the Tuolumne River.

I have attached a map showing the location of the parcel. This parcel is currently undeveloped and has been fallow for many years. The parcel fits into and complements Waterford's Riverfront Park concept as outlined in our current General Plan. We will be looking for further Grant Money and Parkland Dedication Resources in the future to advance the Riverfront Park concept as outlined in our General Plan.
