SUBJECT:

Approval to Accept Used Oil Recycling Block Grant Funds from the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery for Fiscal Years 2009-2010 to 2011-2012

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Authorize the Director of the Department of Environmental Resources, or her designee, to accept 15th Cycle Used Oil Recycling Block Grant funds in the amount of \$54,968 from the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery, for fiscal years 2009-2010 through 2011-2012, to promote used oil and used oil filter recycling.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This grant will provide \$54,968 in reimbursements to the Department of Environmental Resources' Used Oil Recycling Program for expenses to promote and expand used oil and filter recycling opportunities in Stanislaus County and the cities of Hughson, Newman, Oakdale, Patterson, Riverbank, Turlock, and Waterford, for fiscal years 2009-2010 through 2011-2012. Reimbursements are anticipated to not be requested until after July 1, 2010.

DISCUSSION:

In 1991, the California legislature passed the Oil Recycling Enhancement Act (Assembly Bill 2076, amended in 1992 by Assembly Bill 3073). One element of this legislation created a block grant fund for local jurisdictions to be administered by the California Integrated Waste Management Board, formerly known as the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery, for the promotion of waste oil recycling. Grants are available to jurisdictions statewide, either individually or collectively. Funds for this program are collected locally and returned to the community through this block grant program.

On July 21, 2009, the Board granted approval to the Department of Environmental Resources to apply for the 15th Cycle grant funds and adopted a resolution authorizing Stanislaus County to be the lead jurisdiction for the Used Oil Block Grant on behalf of itself and the following participants: the Cities of Hughson, Newman, Oakdale, Patterson, Riverbank, Turlock, and Waterford.

The amount of the grant award is based, in part, upon a calculation by the California Department of Finance, utilizing their population statistics with a per capita rate of \$0.27. Programs paid for by this grant will help the County and the cities within the regional group in meeting the goals and objectives of their Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Elements such as continuing educational efforts aimed at diverting HHW from the waste stream and expanding used oil recycling opportunities, in particular for auto parts stores. All funding is provided on a reimbursement basis. The term of the grant is for three years, July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2012.

POLICY ISSUE:

The Board of Supervisors should determine if accepting Used Oil Recycling Block Grant funds from the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery is consistent with the Board's priorities of a safe community, a healthy community, effective partnerships, and the efficient delivery of public services. Such funding would assist the County and its partner cities in their effort to increase used oil and filter recycling efforts throughout the County.

The Grantee further agrees to abide by the provisions of the following exhibits attached hereto:


