Approval for the Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints, Oakdale Branch, to Have Exclusive Use of a Portion of Muir Point Campgrounds within Woodward Reservoir from May 14, 2010, to May 15, 2010, for their Overnight Camping Event

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Approve the request from the Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints, Oakdale, to have exclusive use of a portion of the Muir Point Campgrounds within Woodward Reservoir for their Overnight Camping Event beginning 3:00 p.m., Friday, May 14, 2010, and ending 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 15, 2010.
2. Direct the Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints, Oakdale Branch, to adhere to the requirements set forth by the Department of Parks and Recreation.
3. Approve the waiver of fees for one day of exclusive use.

FISCAL IMPACT:

If approved, \$90 in exclusive use fees will be waived for the Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints, Oakdale Branch. The revenue generated will be \$300 which consists of overnight camp fees, vehicle fees, and vessel fees.

Approval for the Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints, Oakdale Branch, to Have Exclusive Use of a Portion of Muir Point Campgrounds within Woodward Reservoir from May 14, 2010, to May 15, 2010, for their Overnight Camping Event

DISCUSSION:

A request has been received from the Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints, Oakdale Branch, to have exclusive use of a portion of the Muir Point campgrounds within Woodward Reservoir (Attachment A) for their Overnight Camping Event beginning 3:00 p.m., Friday, May 14, 2010, and ending 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 15, 2010.

Woodward Reservoir is located at 14528 26-Mile Road and a few miles north of Oakdale off Highway 120. The regional park offers 3,767 acres of land and 2,900 acres of reservoir for outdoor recreation and camping activities. This facility offers tent, trailer, and recreational vehicle camping including full hook-up, developed, and undeveloped camping. Daily recreational opportunities include swimming, fishing, boating, picnicking, water and jet skiing, waterfowl hunting, and radio controlled airplane flying. Woodward Reservoir is also home to the County's Annual Fireworks Celebration.

The Department supports this request for exclusive use providing that the Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints, Oakdale Branch, adhere to the following requirements:

- The Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints shall provide the Department of Parks and Recreation a Certificate of Insurance with a minimum of \$1 million liability coverage and shall provide accompanying endorsements naming Stanislaus County as an additional insured. The Certificate of Insurance shall be provided no later than 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 12, 2010.
- An Organization Hold Harmless Agreement is required. The original must be completed and returned no later than 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 12, 2010.
- Individual Hold Harmless Agreements must be completed prior to participating. All original agreements are to be returned to the Department of Parks and Recreation no later than 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 12, 2010. In unforeseen circumstances determined by the Department, participants may submit the agreements no later than 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 19, 2010. Should the Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints, Oakdale Branch, fail to return any or all agreements within the timeframe specified, a \$100.00 administrative fee will be imposed.
- A \$100 Holding Deposit to be applied toward the use of a portion of Muir Point, Woodward Reservoir is due no later than 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 12, 2010.
- The remaining balance of \$200 is payable by Wednesday, May 19, 2010. Fees will cover the use of a portion of Muir Point campgrounds for one night of camping consisting of 10 campsites, 25 vehicles, all vessels, dogs and/or horses. All other fees are applicable.
- A list of pass holders shall be provided to the Department no later than 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 12, 2010. This list will ensure all campers presenting themselves as

part of the camping event are allowed into the facility. Those campers presenting themselves after all 25 passes have been distributed will be responsible for paying the entrance fees.

- The expected number of participants is 50.
- No alcohol shall be sold or served during this exclusive use.
- The exclusive use area within Muir Point campgrounds is to be left in a clean condition and free of litter and debris.

POLICY ISSUE:

The Board of Supervisors should determine if approving the Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints, Oakdale Branch, for exclusive use of a portion of Muir Point campgrounds within Woodward Reservoir is consistent with its priority of effective partnerships.
