SUBJECT: MENTAL HEALTH BOARD

Attached is an application for appointment to the Mental Health Board submitted by Maria Ontiveros. As you are aware, current law requires that 50 percent of the members of the Mental Health Board be consumers and family members. The appointment of Ms. Ontiveros will ensure that Stanislaus County is in compliance with statute.

Statute also states that the Mental Health Board should "reflect the ethnic diversity of the client population of the County". The appointment of Ms. Ontiveros will further ensure that Stanislaus County complies with statute. Ms. Ontiveros is a member of the Latino community as well as a student at Modesto Junior College and will bring her knowledge and experience to the Mental Health Board.

Ms. Ontiveros is a resident of District 4. Since there are no vacancies on the Board in District 4, an out-of-district appointment is requested for her.

The Executive Committee of the Mental Health Board met with Ms. Ontiveros and recommends her appointment. The Department concurs with this recommendation.
